In these two day long workshops, the teachers will observe and learn how moving images can help in deeper and joyful learning, how cleverly chosen film clippings can address diverse learning patterns and turn backbenchers into active learners, how these clippings can catalyse a participatory learning environment in the classroom. Teachers will create their own teaching learning designs using clippings of award winning films from the Vigyan Prasar archive.

The series of workshops opens at the historic Krishnath College School in Berhampore on December 13, 2017. Close at heels follows the Purulia workshop on December 16 & 17.
