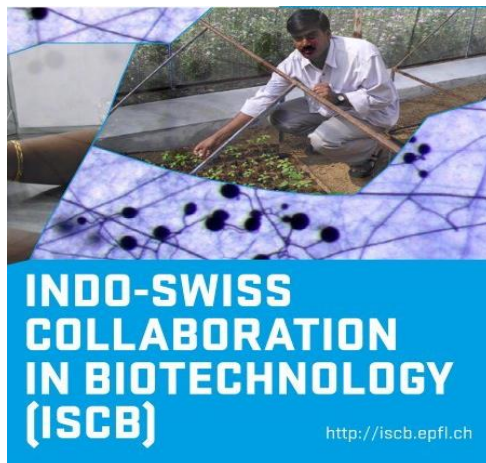


6th Indo-Spanish Joint Programme for Technological Co-operation in Biotechnology



In 2011, the Department of Biotechnology of India (DBT), Govt. of India, and Centre for the Development of Industrial Technology (CDTI), Spain, started a joint programme to promote and fund market driven research and technology development. It also promotes R&D&I collaborations between Indian and Spanish research organisation. The potential proposals are funded by DBT, India and CDTI, Spain.

The call for proposals is a generic call open to collaborative R&D projects in all areas of biotechnology e.g. health biotechnology, industrial biotechnology, nanobiotechnology, agrobiotechnology, including biofuels and bioenergy, bioinformatics and biomedical engineering.

Projects in domains of industry-driven and market-oriented R&D, joint technological cooperation projects between investigators from academic/research organizations and/or industries in India, and industrial partners such as start-ups, SMEs and large companies in Spain involved in innovate products, processes or services development. Stake holders can apply till 27th of March, 2020 (deadline).
