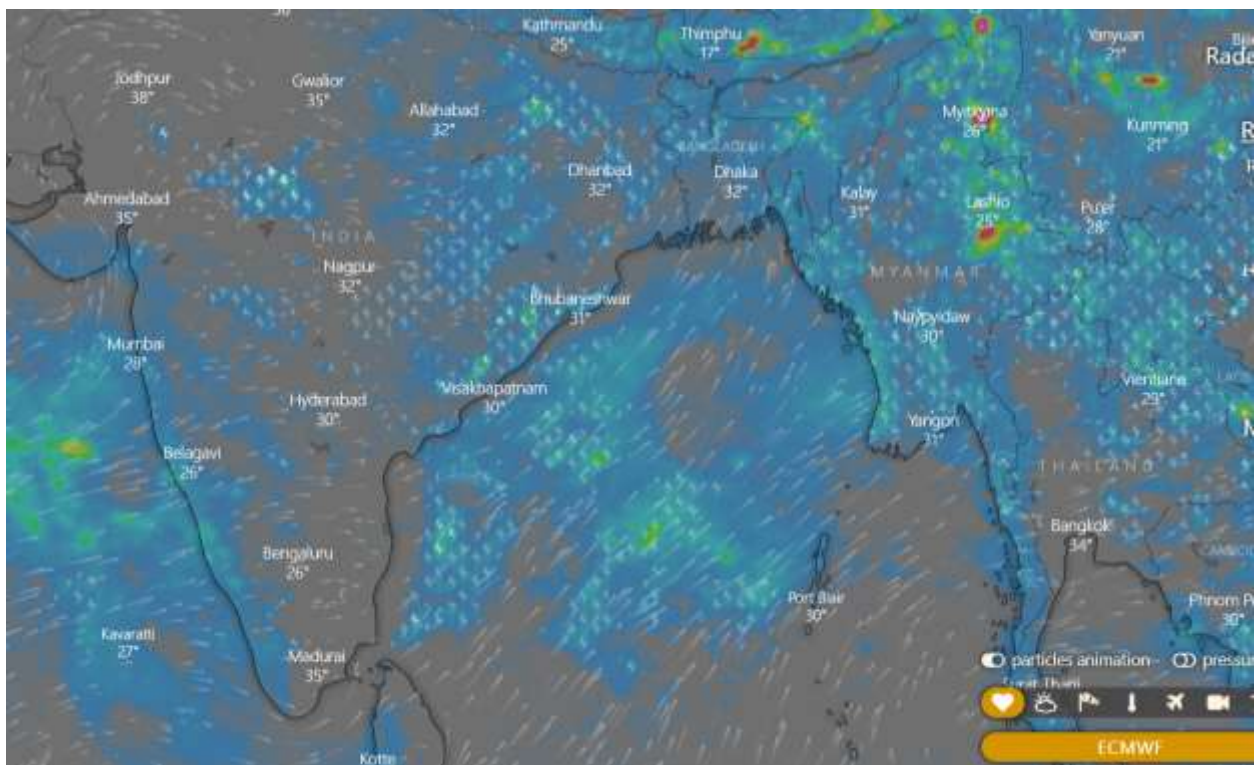


Stay Indoor: IMD issuing rainfall alert for Konkan and Goa

National Weather Forecasting Centre, India Meteorological Department (IMD) is issuing an alert for Konkan and Goa predicting very heavy rainfall during the next 4 days.

As per IMD, strong winds from the Western Disturbance and Bay of Bengal to the lower tropospheric level in northeastern India have created favorable conditions for heavy to very heavy rainfall in eastern Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, West Bengal, and Sikkim and northeastern states during next four days. There is a possibility of heavy to very heavy falls in Eastern Uttar Pradesh and Sub-Himalayan West Bengal and Sikkim from 2 July to 3 July 2020.

IMD is also issuing a strong wind alert for Eastcentral & East Arabian Sea and along & off Gujarat-Maharashtra-Goa-Karnataka-Kerala coasts, Lakshadweep and the north Andaman Sea during the next four days. Fishermen are advised not to venture into this area during the period. However, West Rajasthan is likely to experience conditions of a heatwave from 1 July to 5 July 2020.
