**Air quality in Delhi, Mumbai, Pune, and Ahmedabad is satisfactory today: quality to deteriorate tomorrow in Delhi**

New Delhi, August 5 (Vigyan Samachar): System of Air Quality and Weather Forecasting and Research (SAFAR), Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology, release a forecast of air quality for Delhi, Mumbai, Pune, and Ahmedabad.

According to SAFAR, Delhi's Air Quality Index (AQI) is satisfactory today on 05 August 2020 and will become unsatisfactory tomorrow. A shift in wind direction from southwest direction to easterly and strengthening of wind speed is forecasted marginal improvement in is expecting by 6 August 2020.

As per SAFAR, air quality for Pune, Mumbai, and Ahmedabad continues to be in the best category. Under the influence of low-pressure areas in West Bengal, the monsoon southwesterly flow has strengthened and created favorable conditions for heavy rain over Konkan during the next two days.
