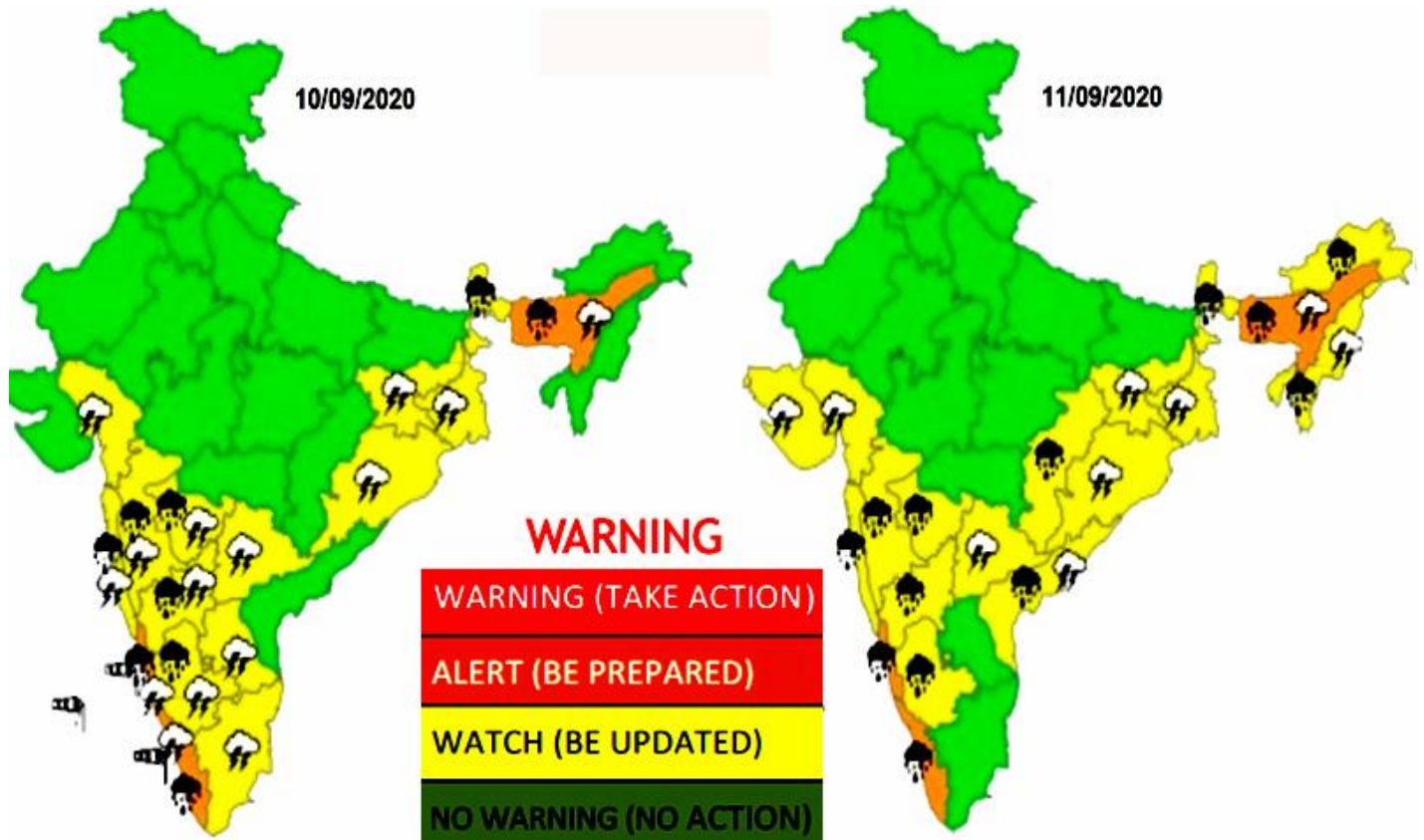


Countrywide Weather Alert from IMD

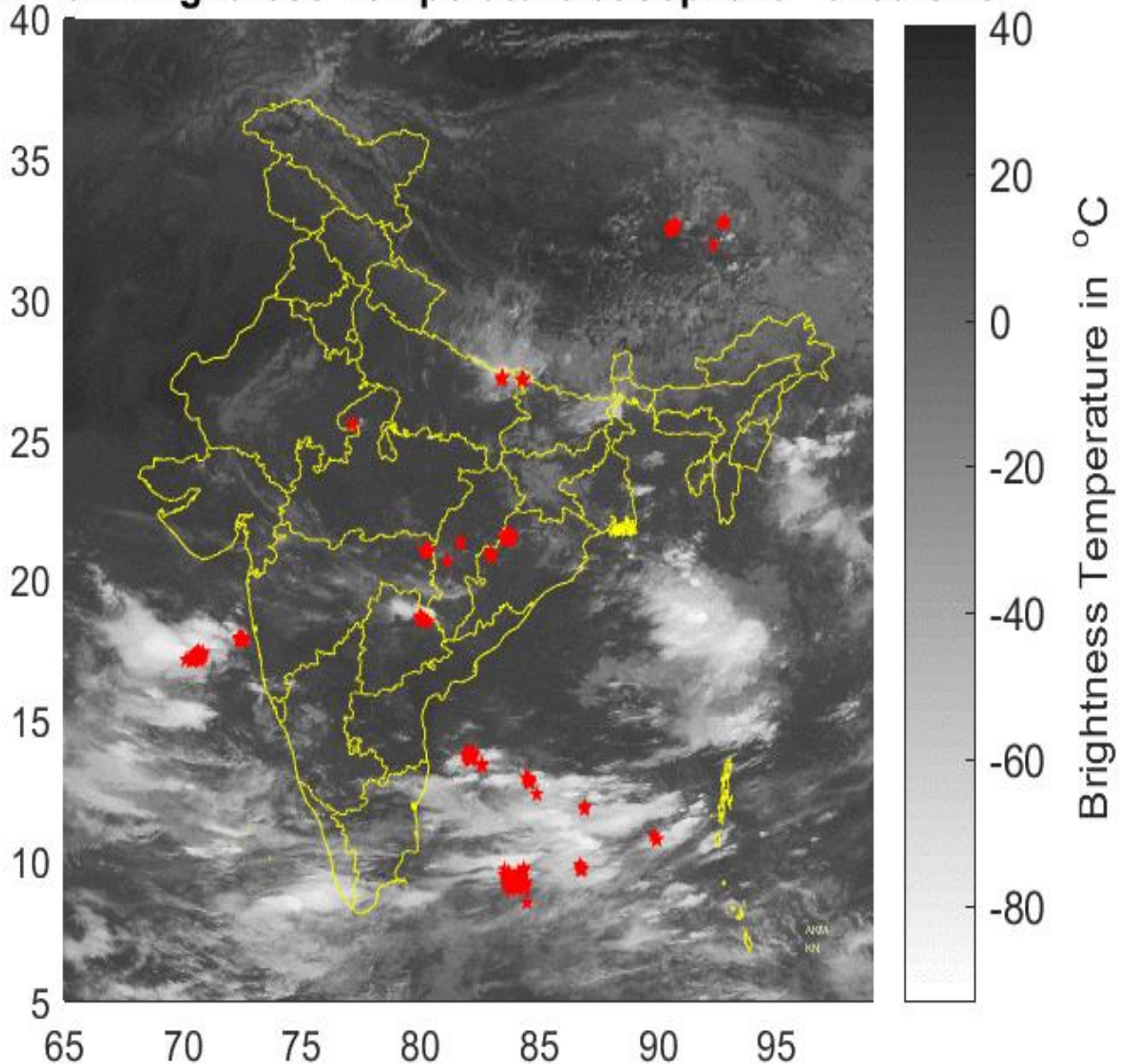
New Delhi, 9th September (Vigyan Samachar): India Meteorological Department (IMD) is issuing an alert for Coastal Karnataka, Kerala and Mahe predicting heavy to very heavy rainfall during 10 to 11 September 2020. There is a possibility of very heavy rainfall in Assam, Meghalaya and Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim on 10th September 2020.



As per IMD, low pressure developed over Westcentral Bay of Bengal off Andhra Pradesh coast around 13 September 2020 have created favorable conditions for heavy to very heavy rainfall in Odisha, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Yanam, Telangana, Vidarbha and adjoining areas during 12 September to 14 September.

Monsoon trough is active and lies near to its normal position. In addition, cyclonic circulation lies over West Assam and adjoining SubHimalayan West Bengal & Sikkim in lower tropospheric levels have created favorable conditions for heavy rainfall with thunderstorm and lightning over Northeast India and Sub-Himalayan West Bengal and Sikkim on 10 September 2020, said IMD.

As per the National Weather Forecasting Centre, IMD forecast, there is a heavy probability of thunderstorms with lightning in Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Yanam, East Uttar Pradesh, Vidarbha, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, East Rajasthan, Telangana, Rayalseema, Tamilnadu, Puducherry, Karaikal, Karnataka, Kerala, Mahe during next 12 hours.
