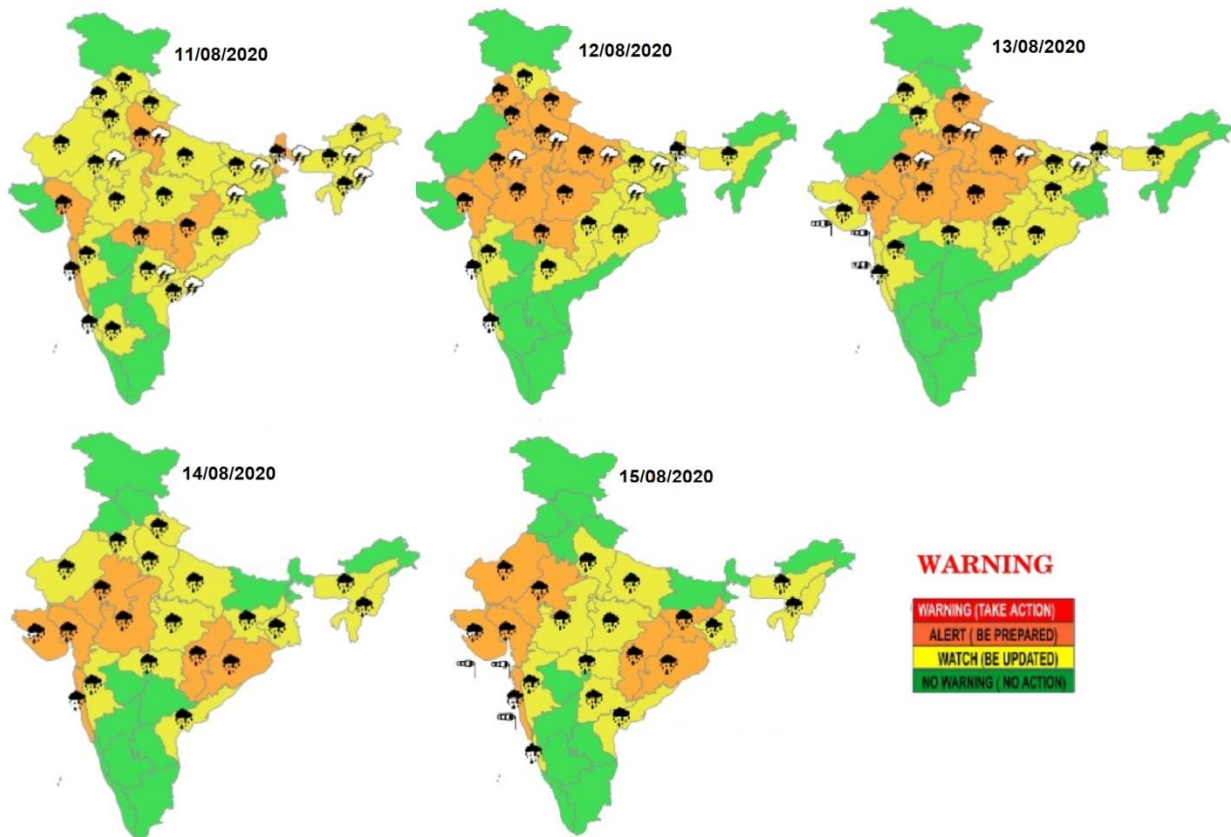


### Countrywide weather alert from IMD

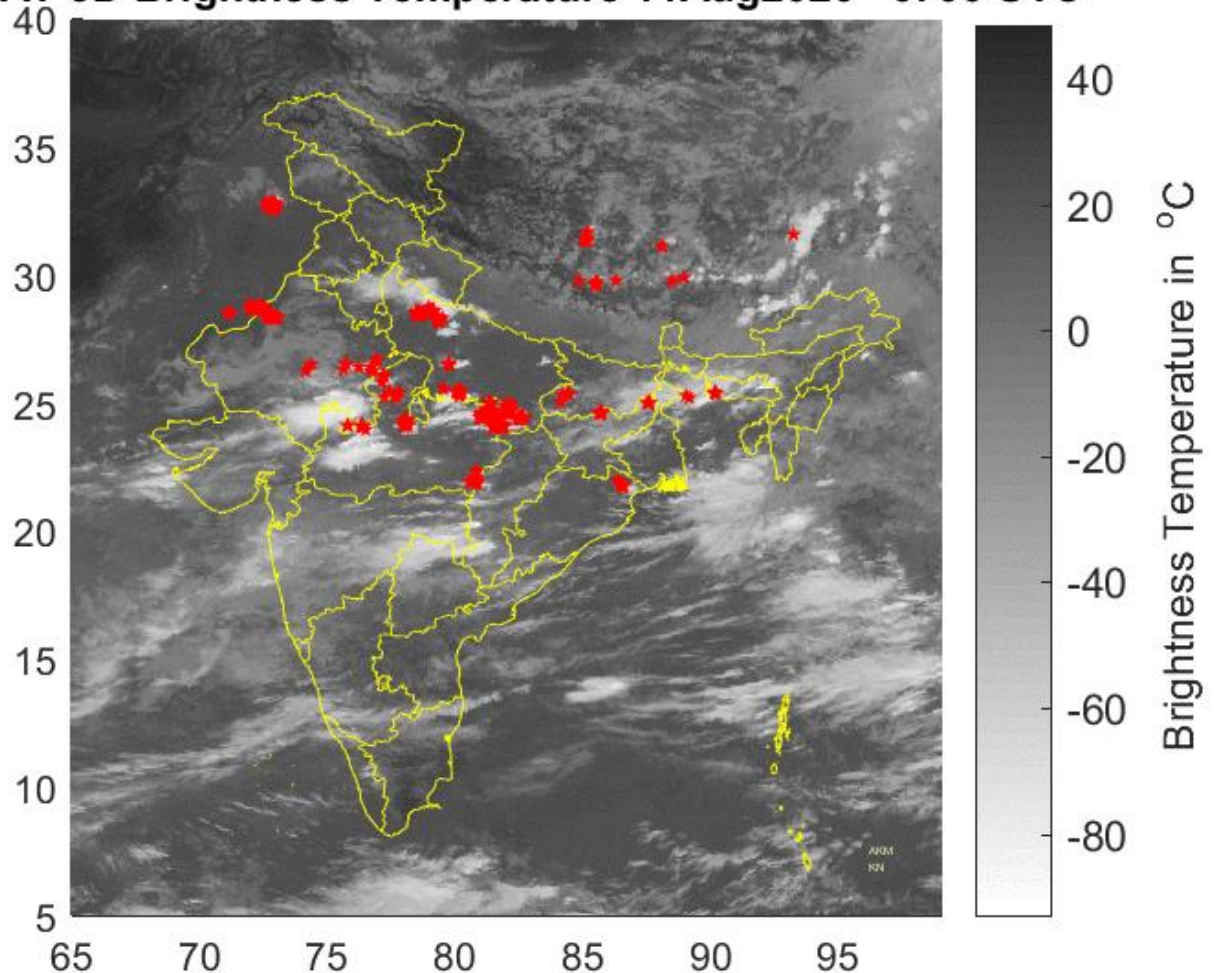
New Delhi, 11<sup>th</sup> August (Vigyan Samachar): National Weather Forecasting Centre, India Meteorological Department (IMD) is issuing an alert for **Gujarat region** predicting **very heavy rainfall** to **extremely heavy falls** on 14 August 2020. There are also possibilities of **extremely heavy rainfall** in **Rajasthan, Chhattisgarh, Odisha and Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam** on 15 August 2020.



As per IMD, low-pressure areas that formed over northwest Madhya Pradesh & neighbourhood is very likely to move northwestwards and merge with the monsoon trough during next 24 hours. In addition, cyclonic circulation lies over Northwest Bay of Bengal & neighbourhood have created favorable conditions for **heavy to very heavy rainfall** in **Western Himalayan region, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Delhi, Uttar**

**Pradesh and East Rajasthan** during 11-12 August 2020, and **Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat** region during next 4 days. There are also possibilities of heavy to very heavy rainfall with high intensity over north **Gujarat** and **southwest Madhya Pradesh** on **13 and 14 August 2020**.

**Moderate to intense thunderstorm & lightning over northeast Rajasthan and western parts of Uttar Pradesh**, during the next 4 days, said IMD. There are also possibilities of moderate thunderstorm & lightning over **Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and Telangana** during **13-15 August 2020**.
