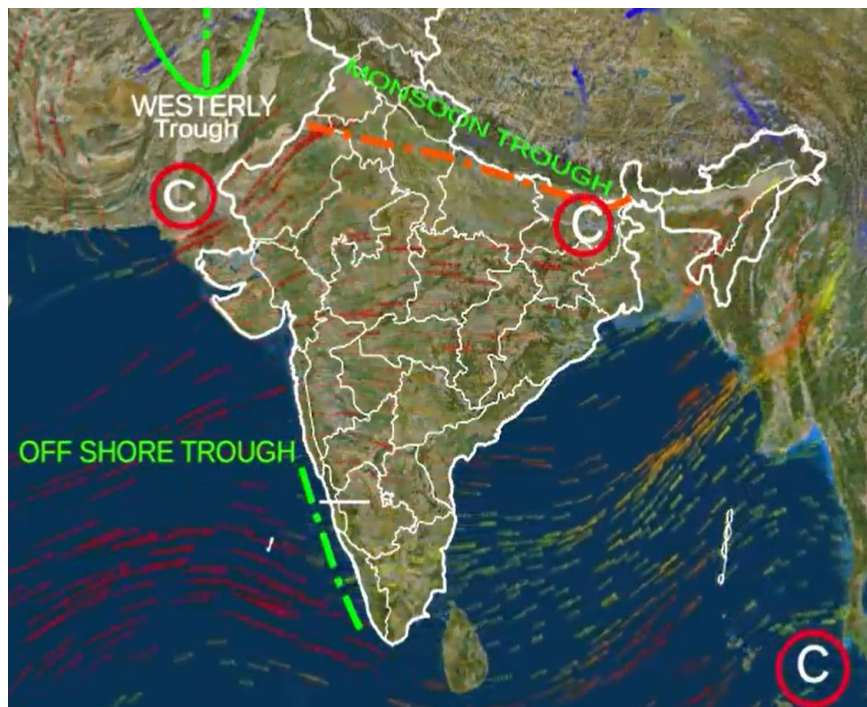


## Stay Indoor: High wave, wind alert for Gujarat and Tamil Nadu

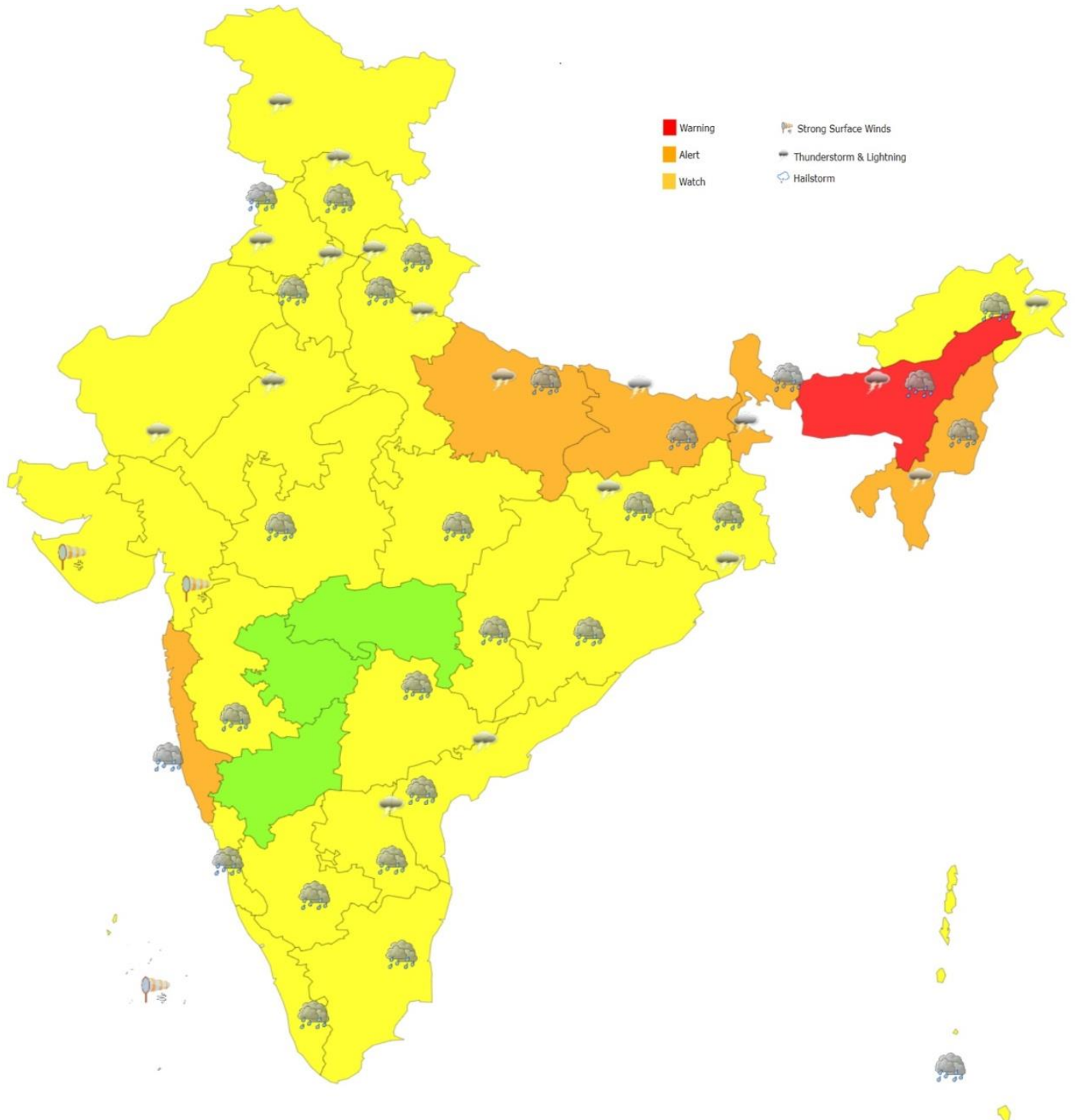
A high wave and wind red alert has been issued by the ESSO-Indian National Center for Ocean Information Services (INCOIS) for Gujarat and Tamil Nadu during the next 48 hours. Fishermen are advised not to venture into this area during next 48 hours. INCOIS also issued orange warning alert of High wave and wind for, Maharashtra, Kerala, Lakshadweep, Goa, Karnataka, Andaman and Nicobar during next 48 hours.



High Swell Alerts from INCOIS are being issued for Gujarat coast, and Lakshadweep ongoing condition and valid until the night of today 13 July 2020.

As per Meteorological Department of India (IMD), a cyclonic circulation lies over East Bihar & neighbourhood at mid and upper tropospheric levels. Western disturbances and southerly/ southwesterly winds from Bay of Bengal moving at lower tropospheric levels in the northeast & adjoining east India have created conditions that are favorable for extreme heavy rainfalls over Sub Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim on 13 July, 2020. Intensity of rainfall over these regions is likely to reduce gradually thereafter. There is a possibility of heavy to very heavy

falls in northeast India, West Bengal, Sikkim, Bihar and adjoining East Uttar Pradesh during next 4 days, said IMD.



IMD is also issuing a strong wind alert for Southwest and Westcentral Arabian Sea during next 5 days. Fishermen are advised not to venture into sea over these areas.
