IMD weather forecasts for different parts of the country during next 4-5 days

New Delhi, November 18, 2020 (Vigyan Samachar)

India Meteorological Department (IMD) is issuing an alert for Kerala, Mahe and Lakshadweep predicting heavy rainfall from 18th November 2020 onward with a possibility of scattered to fairly widespread moderate rainfall accompanied with thunderstorm & lightning over Kerala, Mahe and Lakshadweep on 19th & 20th November, 2020.

Due to the influence of a fresh Western Disturbance, isolated to scattered light rain/snow fall is expected over Western Himalayan region from 18th to 20th November 2020. However, dry weather would prevail in most of the other parts of the northwest India during this period.

IMD predicts a gradual dipping of temperature to as low as 2-4°C minimum during next 4-5 day in northwest India and north Madhya Pradesh during the next 4-5 days.

While towards down south on India, the National Weather Forecasting Centre anticipates a heavy probability of thunderstorms with lightning in Coastal & South Interior Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry, Karaikal, Kerala, Mahe and Lakshadweep on 18th and 19th November.
