

36th Geological Congress (IGC) rescheduled to 16-21 August 2021

International Geological Congress Community (IGCC) postponed the **36th Geological Congress (36th IGC) from November 2020 to 16-21 August 2021**. Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES), Ministry of Mines, and Indian National Science Academy is going to organize the 36th International Geological Congress (IGCs) at India Expo Center and Mart, Delhi, India which is a prestigious global event for the advancement of Earth Sciences.



The main aim of the event is to bring together the geoscientific community across the continents and oceans with an opportunity to create an organizational framework for the development of Earth Sciences. With as many as 13 plenary talks and one public lecture by outstanding geoscientists from across the world, the highlight of this event would be 45 science themes, more than 40 parallel sessions and 71 exciting field trips spread in India and neighboring countries.

The event would facilitate a better understanding of the different geological aspects involving meteorology, oceanography and earth sciences (such river chemistry, geophysics and mathematical geosciences) and to evaluate long-term global climate control measures.
