

**State wise Coronavirus Status in India as on 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2020, 2:30 pm**

India is in its second week of the 2nd phase of a 19-day nationwide lockdown imposed by the Central Government to reduce the spread of coronavirus in the country. As of 22 April 2020, outbreaks of COVID-19 have affected 19,984, people across the country including 15,474 active cases. So far 3870 patients have either been cured or discharged while 640 deaths have been recorded in the Country. At 5,218, Maharashtra has the highest number of cases among Indian states. Coronavirus cases reached 2156 in Delhi as per data provided by the Union Ministry for Health and Family Welfare.

The Ministry of Health also stated that the death rate in India is around 3.3%. An age-wise analysis suggests that 14.4% of deaths occurred in the age group 0–45 years. For the 45-60 years age group it is 10.3%; for 60-75 years it is 33.1% and for 75 years and above it is 42.2%.
