

Stay Indoor: IMD extreme rainfall alert for Assam and Meghalaya

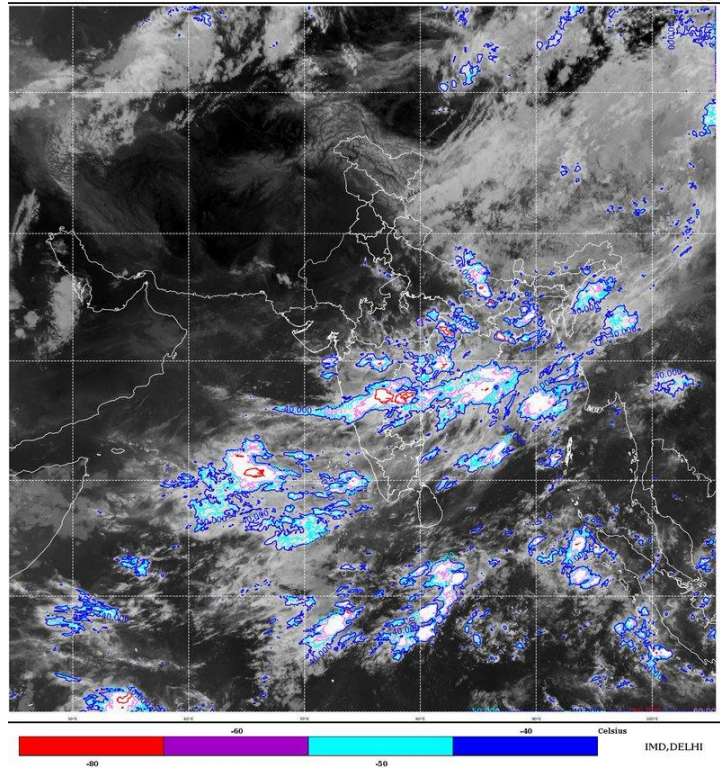
National Weather Forecasting Centre, India Meteorological Department (IMD) is issuing an alert for, Assam and Meghalaya on 23 July 2020.



As per IMD, strong winds from the Western Disturbance and Bay of Bengal to the lower tropospheric level in Northeast and adjoining East India have created favorable conditions for heavy to very heavy rainfall in Central, East & Northeast India and Maharashtra during next 2 days and decrease in intensity thereafter. There is a possibility of heavy to very heavy falls in Uttarakhand from 25 July to 26 July 2020, said IMD.

Moderate to intense thunderstorm & lightning over Bihar, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Odisha, Gangetic West Bengal and Telangana during next 12 hours, said IMD

IMD is also issuing a strong wind alert for Southwest and Westcentral Arabian Sea and squally weather alert Eastcentral & Northwest Arabian Sea and along & off Karnataka-Maharashtra coasts during the next four days. Fishermen are advised not to venture into this area during the period.
