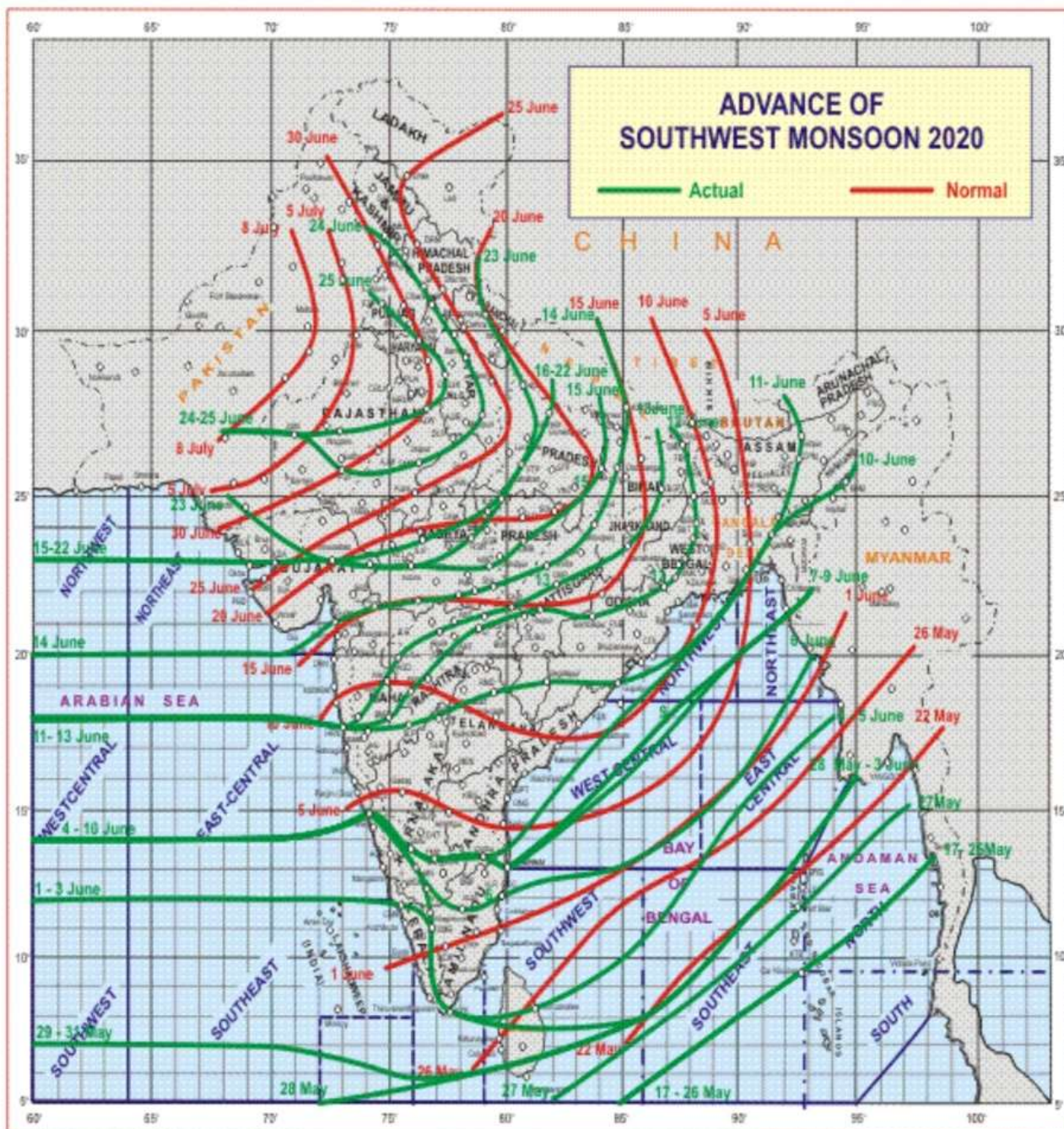


Extreme rainfall alert for Assam, Meghalaya, Bihar, Kerala and Mahe, Puducherry: IMD advisory to stay indoor

India Meteorological Department (IMD) is issuing an alert for Bihar, Assam, Meghalaya, Kerala and Mahe predicting extremely heavy rainfall during the next 48 hours.

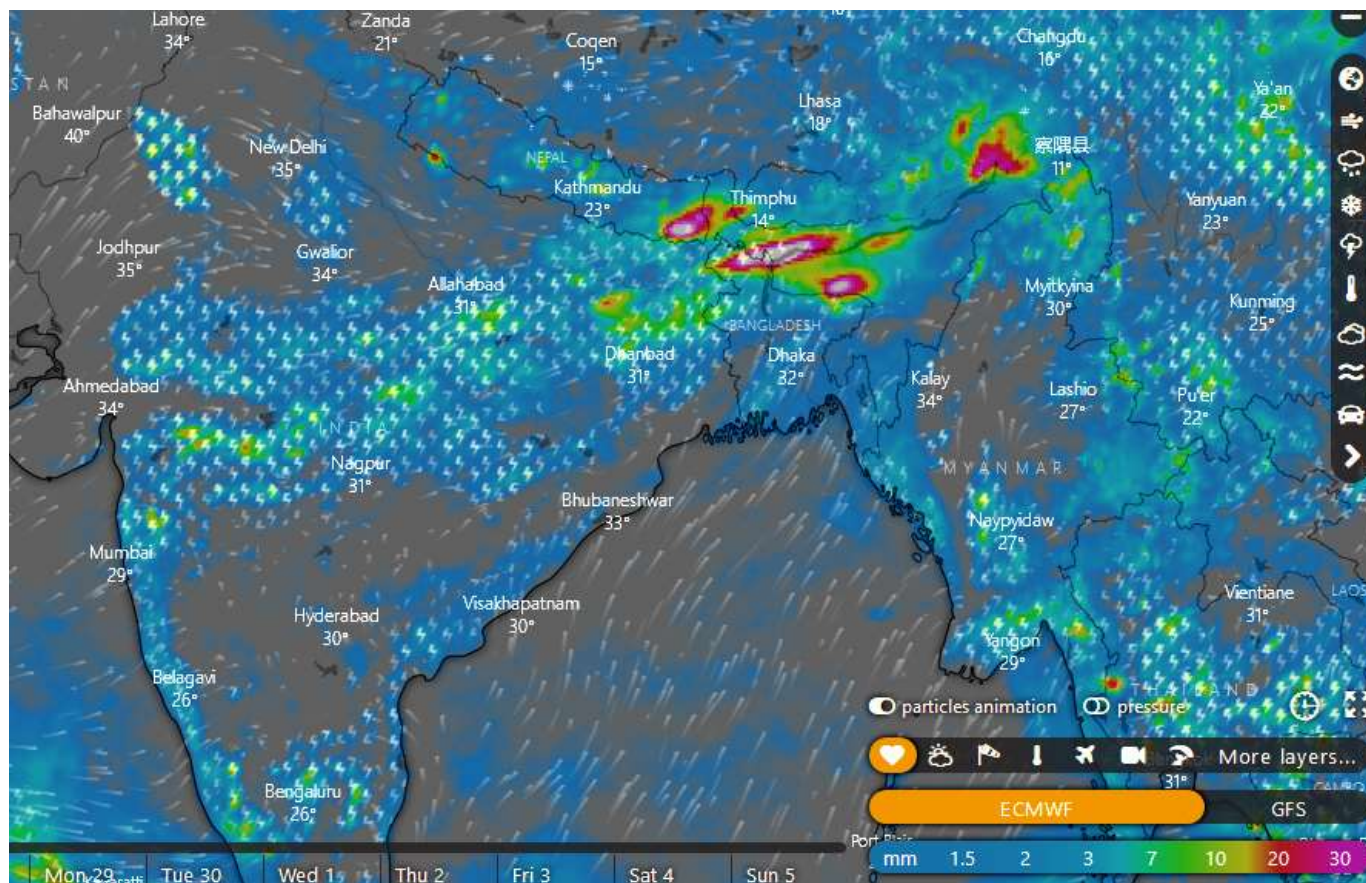


Western disturbance and strong southerly/south-westerly winds from Bay of Bengal to northeast and adjoining east India have created conditions that are favorable for heavy to very heavy rain fall to continue over the northeast and adjoining east India during next 3 days”, said IMD.

As per IMD, Southwest Monsoon has further advanced yesterday into some more parts of Rajasthan, remaining parts of Uttar Pradesh and Himachal Pradesh, entire Delhi, some parts of Haryana and most parts of Punjab.

IMD is also issuing a strong wind alert for Southwest & adjoining West-central Arabian Sea, East-central Arabian sea and Squally Weather over Lakshadweep area, Kerala-Karnataka coasts and Southeast Arabian sea during the next four days.

Fishermen are advised not to venture into this area during the period.
