

IMD Weather forecast and weather warning for next 4 days

The India Meteorological Department, Ministry of Earth Sciences, Government of India predicts that fresh Western Disturbance is likely to affect the Western Himalayan region from the night of January 28, 2020.

28th January, 2020:

- **Heavy rain/snow** very likely at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand
- **Thunderstorm** accompanied with **hail and lightning**, very likely at a few places over Punjab and Haryana & Chandigarh; at isolated places in Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand and West Uttar Pradesh and with lightning at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, East Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, Bihar, East Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh and Jharkhand.
- **Dense fog** very likely in isolated parts over Northwest Rajasthan
- **Cold day** conditions very likely in isolated part over Uttarakhand

29th January, 2020:

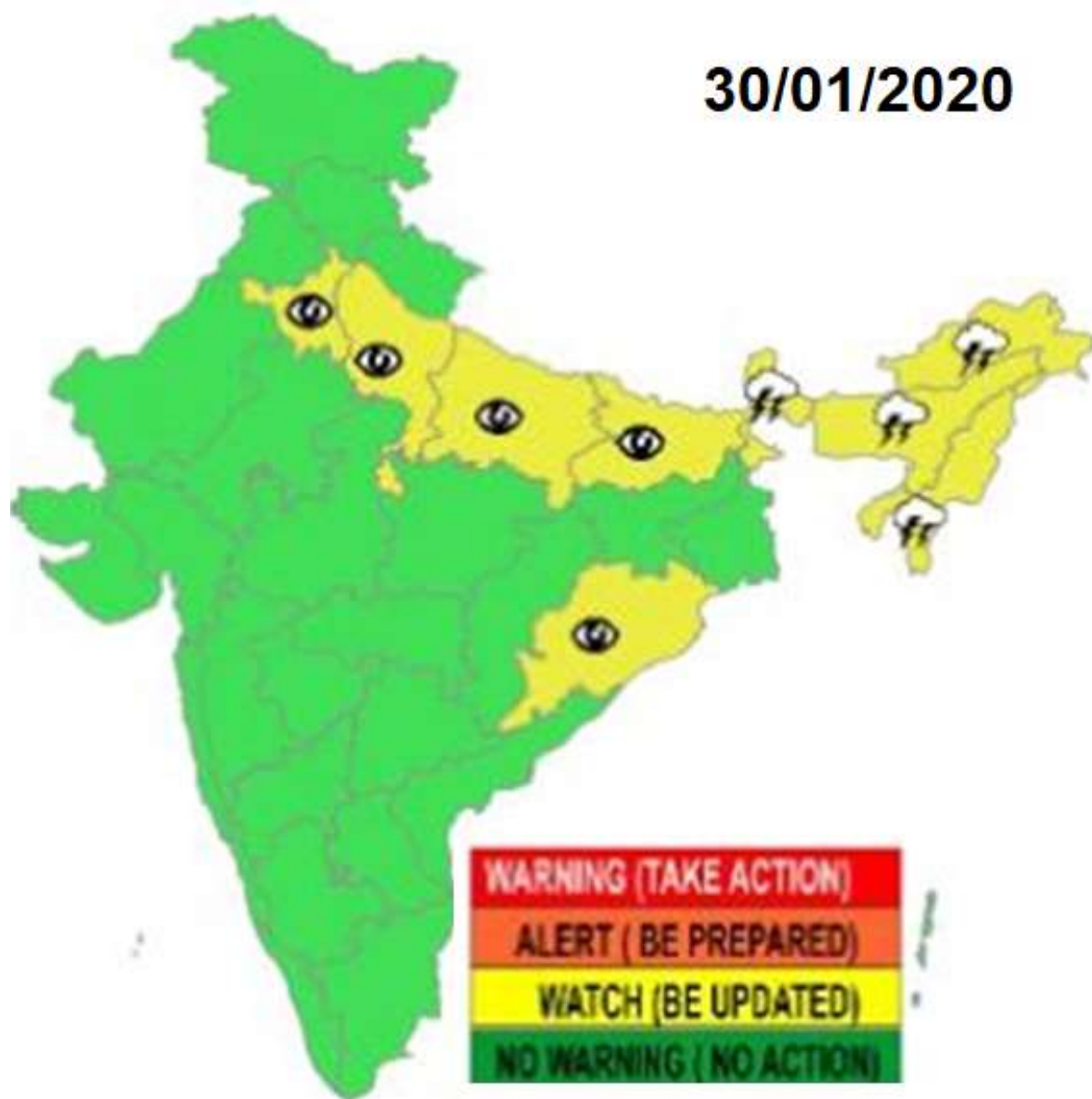
- **Thunderstorm** accompanied with **hail and lightning, very** likely at isolated places over Uttarakhand and with lightning at isolated places over Uttar Pradesh, Gangetic West Bengal and Odisha
- **Dense fog** very likely in isolated places over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh and Delhi, North Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar and Odisha
- Cold day conditions very likely in isolated place over Uttarakhand

30th January, 2020:

- **Thunderstorm** accompanied with **lightning**, likely at isolated places over Uttarakhand and with lightning at isolated places over sub-Himachal, West Bengal, Sikkim, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoran and Tripura.
- **Dense fog** very likely in isolated places over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh and Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar and Odisha

31st January, 2020:

- **Thunderstorm** accompanied with hail and **lightning**, likely at isolated places over Uttarakhand and with lightning at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoran and Tripura.
- **Dense fog** very likely in isolated places over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Delhi and Uttar Pradesh
