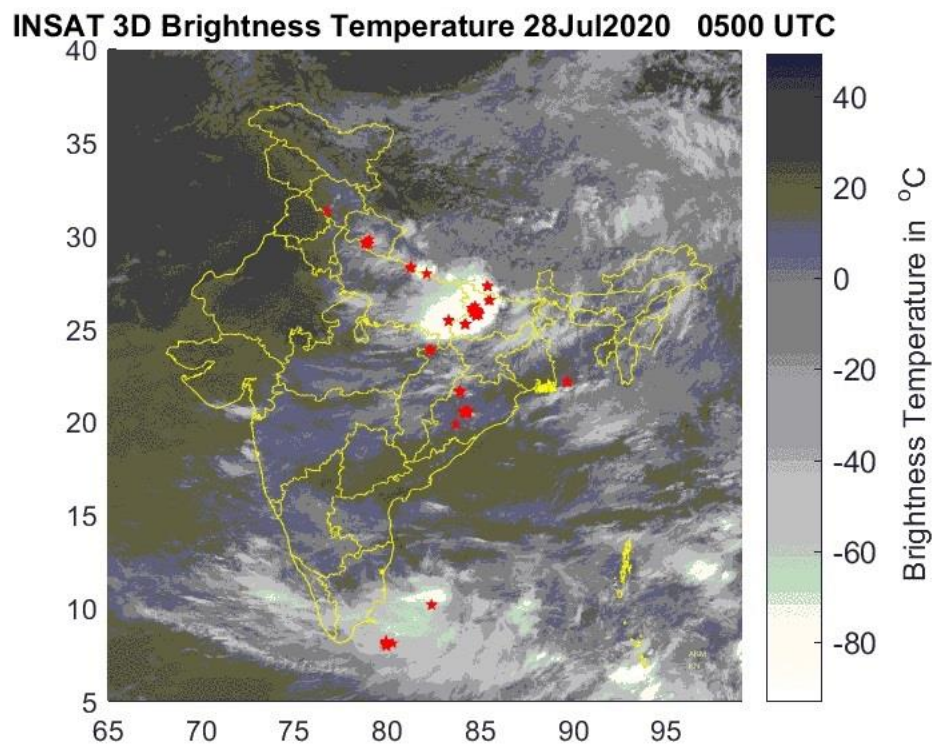

IMD predicts thunderstorm with lighting at many parts of the country during next 5 days

National Weather Forecasting Centre, India Meteorological Department (IMD), Ministry of Earth Sciences is issuing a alert for south Haryana, Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand, Odisha and Gangetic West Bengal, predicting intense thunderstorm with light intermittent rains during next 12 hours.



As per IMD, under the influence of the depression, there is also probability of thunderstorms with light intermittent rains in many parts of the country during the next 3-4 five days.

The following places are very likely to experience this: Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Bihar,

Jharkhand, West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram, Tripura, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema and Tamil Nadu, Puducherry, and Karaika.

IMD is also issuing a strong wind alert for Southwest & adjoining Westcentral Arabian Sea and Squally Weather over Southeast and adjoining Central Bay of Bengal & adjoining Andaman Sea and along & off Karnataka-Kerala coast & Lakshadweep area during the next four days. Fishermen are advised not to venture into this area during the period
