Meeting on Research proposal on Arabian sea studies under Indo-US collaboration

Ministry of Earth Sciences, Government of India organised a meeting on Arabian Sea studies under Indo-US collaboration held at the National Institute of Ocean Technology on **30 January 2020**.



India and the US would work on creating a common knowledge platform and exchanging best practices. This partnership will also help to create incentives for cooperative growth in the Arabian Sea and to maintain a rule-based order to foster openness, respect for sovereignty and international law, stability and free and fair trade.

In the Indo-Pacific areas, the US can help promote regional collaboration to explore new and environmentally conscious investment opportunities in marine economic activities and industries, such as food production and coastal tourism; Direct investment in Indian projects, such as the creation of coastal economic zones, can also be expected to create a market-driven blue economy.
