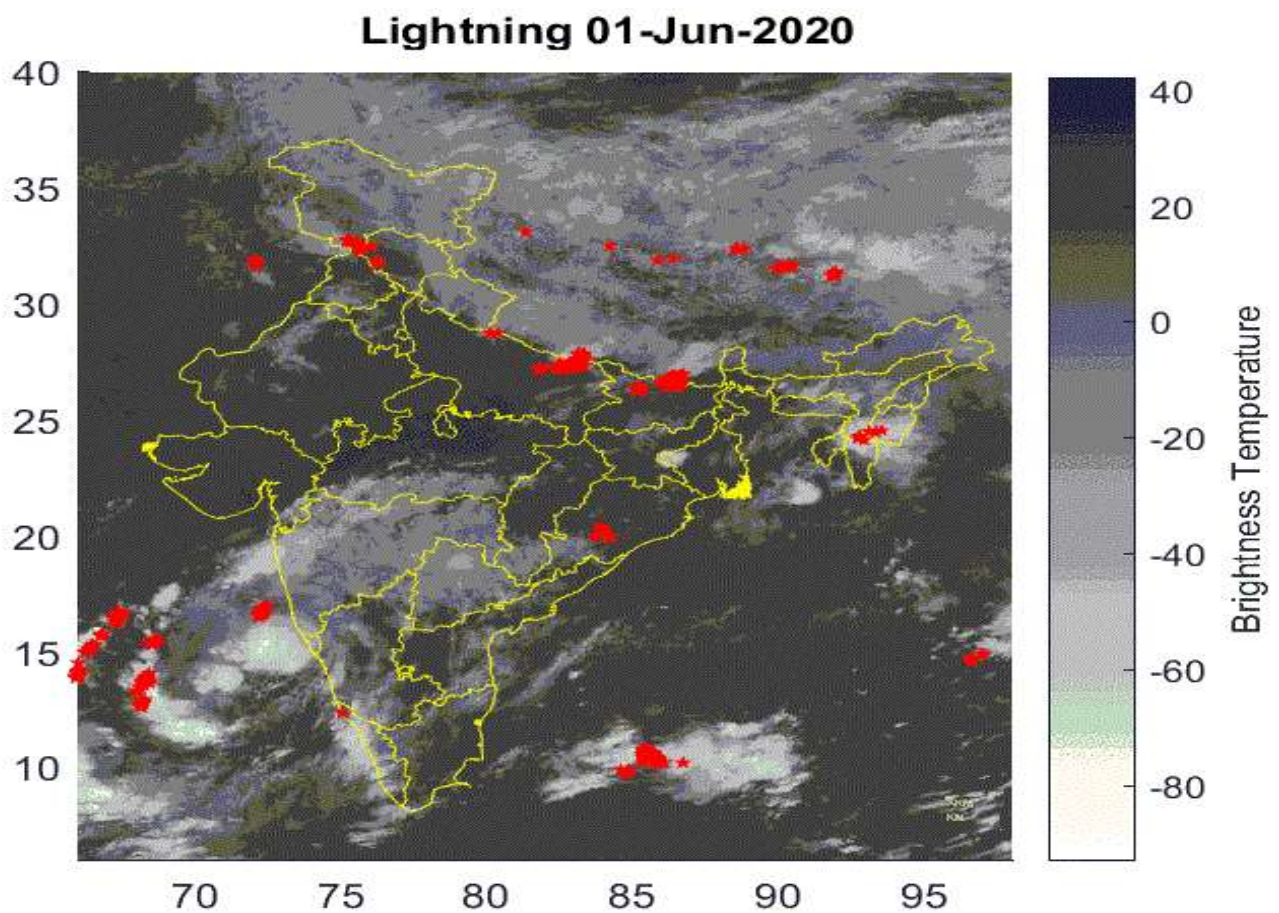

## IMD predicts thunderstorm with lighting at many parts of the country

National Weather Forecasting Centre, India Meteorological Department (IMD), Ministry of Earth Sciences is issuing a red alert for Gujarat, Daman, Diu, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, predicting extreme rainfall from 6 June 2020 to 8 June.



As per IMD, under the influence of the depression, there is heavy probability of thunderstorms with light intermittent rains in many parts of the country during the next five days.

The following places are very likely to experience this:

Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Uttar Pradesh, Jharkhand, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, West Bengal, Sikkim, Assam, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram, Tripura, Maharashtra, Goa, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Yanam, Karnataka, Kerala, Mahe, Lakshadweep, Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan, Muzaffarabad , Vidarbha, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, and Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal.

However, dry weather is likely to prevail over the remaining parts of the country, said officials at IMD.
