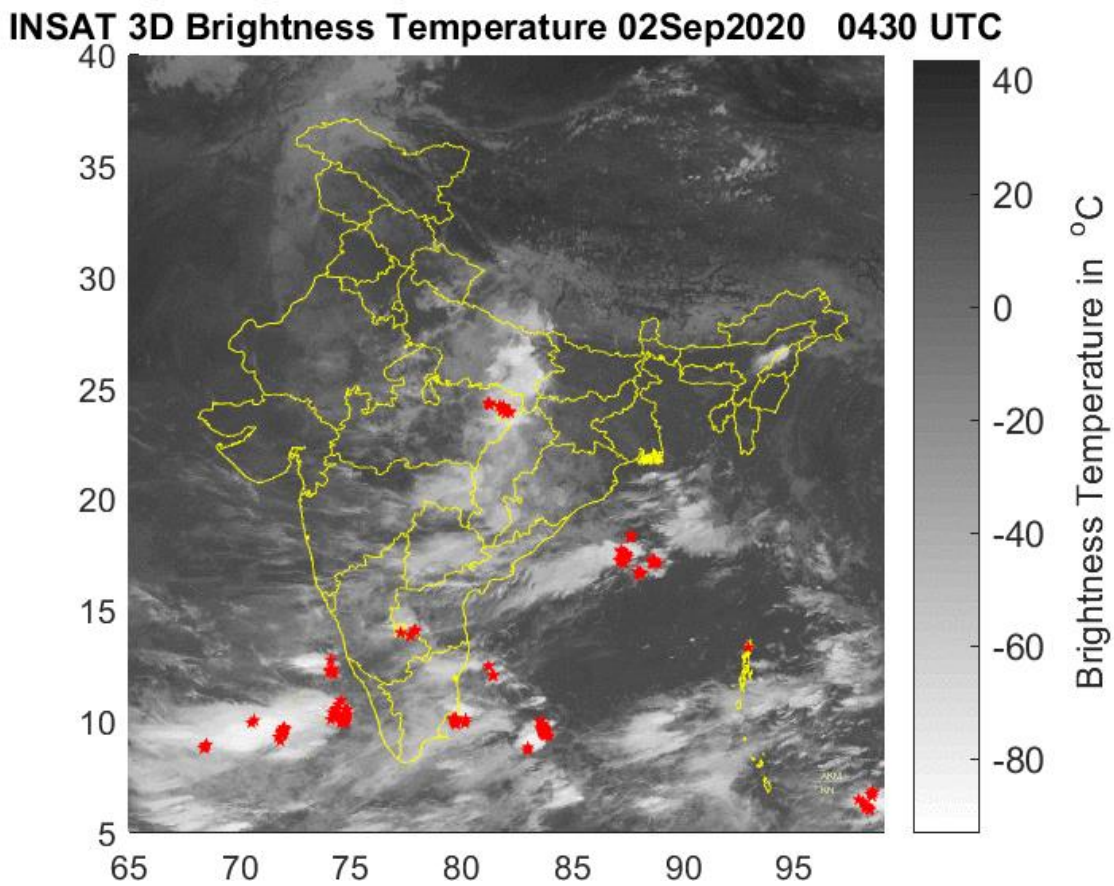


Weather Alerts

Stay Indoor: Thunderstorm with lightning likely at many parts of the country during next two days

New Delhi, 2nd September (Vigyan Samachar): As per the National Weather Forecasting Centre, India Meteorological Department (IMD), Ministry of Earth Sciences forecast, there is a heavy probability of thunderstorms with lightning in many parts of the country during the next 4 days.

The following places are very likely to experience this: East Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Karnataka, Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Kerala & Mahe during next two days, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Konkan & Goa and South Interior Karnataka during 4-6 September 2020.



As per IMD, cyclonic circulation lies over Gangetic West Bengal & neighbourhood and south Assam & neighbourhood in the lower tropospheric levels have created favorable conditions for heavy to very heavy rainfall in Odisha and Chhattisgarh today, the 2 September & over south Interior Karnataka, Kerala and Tamilnadu during next 48 hours. There is a possibility of extremely heavy rainfall over Assam and Meghalaya during 4-6 September 2020.
