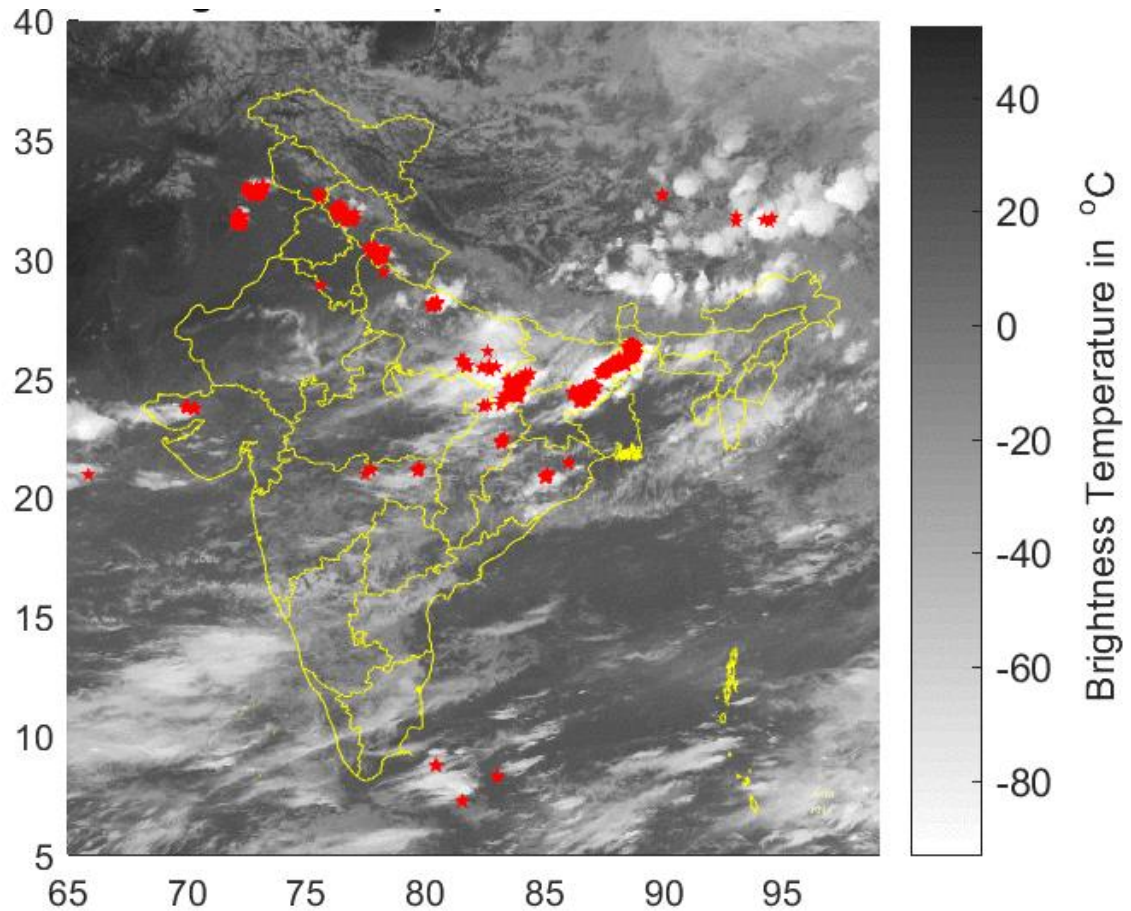
IMD issuing extremely heavy rainfall alert for Bihar, Assam, Meghalaya and other parts of the country

National Weather Forecasting Centre, India Meteorological Department (IMD) is issuing an alert for Bihar, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Assam, Meghalaya and Arunachal Pradesh predicting extremely heavy rainfall during the next 48 hours.

As per IMD, strong winds from the Western Disturbance and Bay of Bengal to the lower tropospheric level in northeastern India from today onward have created favorable conditions for heavy to very heavy rainfall in Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, northern parts of Punjab, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim and northeastern states during next 4 to 5 days.

There is a possibility of extremely heavy rainfalls Uttarakhand & West Uttar Pradesh from 11 July to 12 July, Bihar on 10 July to 11 July, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, East Uttar Pradesh and Bihar during 10 to 11 July 2020.



IMD has issued a red alert for Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Jharkhand, parts of Madhya Pradesh, northeast Rajasthan, north Chhattisgarh and parts of Odisha predicting thunderstorm and lightning during next 2 Days.

IMD has also issued a strong wind alert for Southwest and Westcentral Arabian Sea, and the North & Eastcentral Arabian Sea and Gujarat coast during the next five days. Fishermen are advised not to venture into this area during the period mentioned.
