INCOIS-IMD issuing countrywide swell surge and high wind alert: Fishermen advised not to venture out

New Delhi, January 11, 2021 (Vigyan Samachar)

A swell surge and high wind orange alert has been issued by the ESSO-Indian National Center for Ocean Information Services (INCOIS) for Maharashtra, Goa, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Kerala, Andhra Pradesh and Lakshadweep during the next 48 hours and high wind orange alert for Gujarat. Fishermen are advised not to venture into this area during above mentioned period.

INCOIS is issuing a strong wind alert for Lakshadweep area, Southeast Arabian Sea and adjoining East-central Arabian Sea on 12 January and 13 January 2021 and over Comorin area on 11 January and 12 January 2021. Fishermen are advised not to venture into this area during this period.

INCOIS is issuing a squally weather alert over prevail over Gulf of Mannar & Comorin area during 11-12 January 2021 and Lakshadweep area during 12-13 January 2021. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these area during this period.

As per INCOIS forecast, low lying areas of Maharashtra (Malvan, Munage, Phanase, Velas, Colaba, Gateway of India), Goa (Mormugoa, Panjim, Vasco da Gama), Kerala (Kollam, Alappuzha, Kochi, Ponnani, Kozhikode, Kannur, Kasargod), Lakshadweep (Amini, Kavaratti and Kiltan Islands), Tamil Nadu (Kanyakumari, Thoosthukudi, Ramanathapuram), and Karnataka (Udupi, Murudeswar, Gokarna, Mashem) to witness extreme swell surges during next two days.

INCOIS-IMD also issued an advisory for the boats to be anchored at fair distances to avoid collision and damage in above areas during next two days. Fishermen are advised not to venture out
