

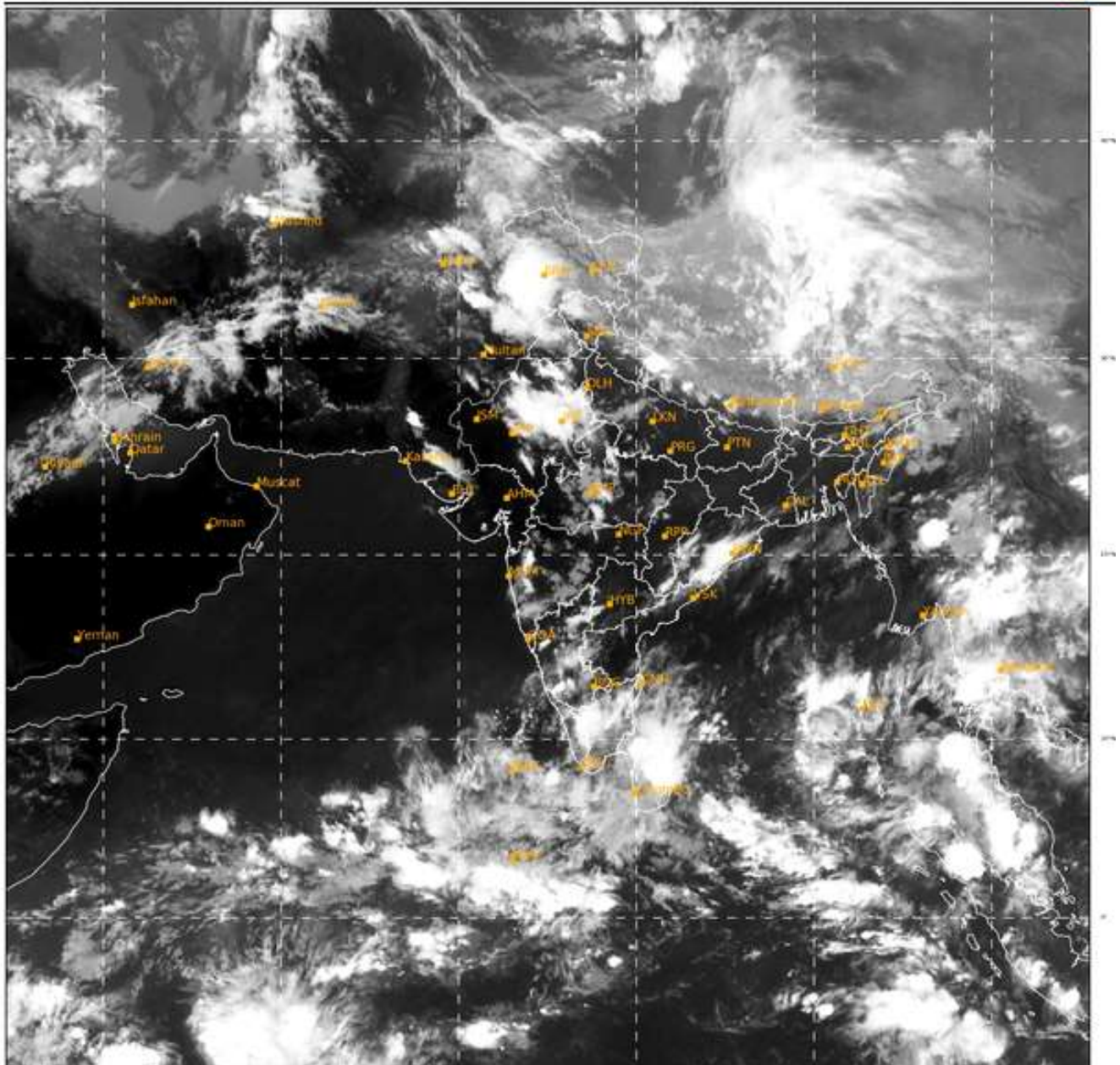
## IMD predicts thunderstorm and lightening over many states of India during next 5 days

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As per the India Meteorological Department (IMD) forecast, thunderstorm and lightening to continue in the northeast India over the next 5 days with activities to peak up during 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> May 2020.

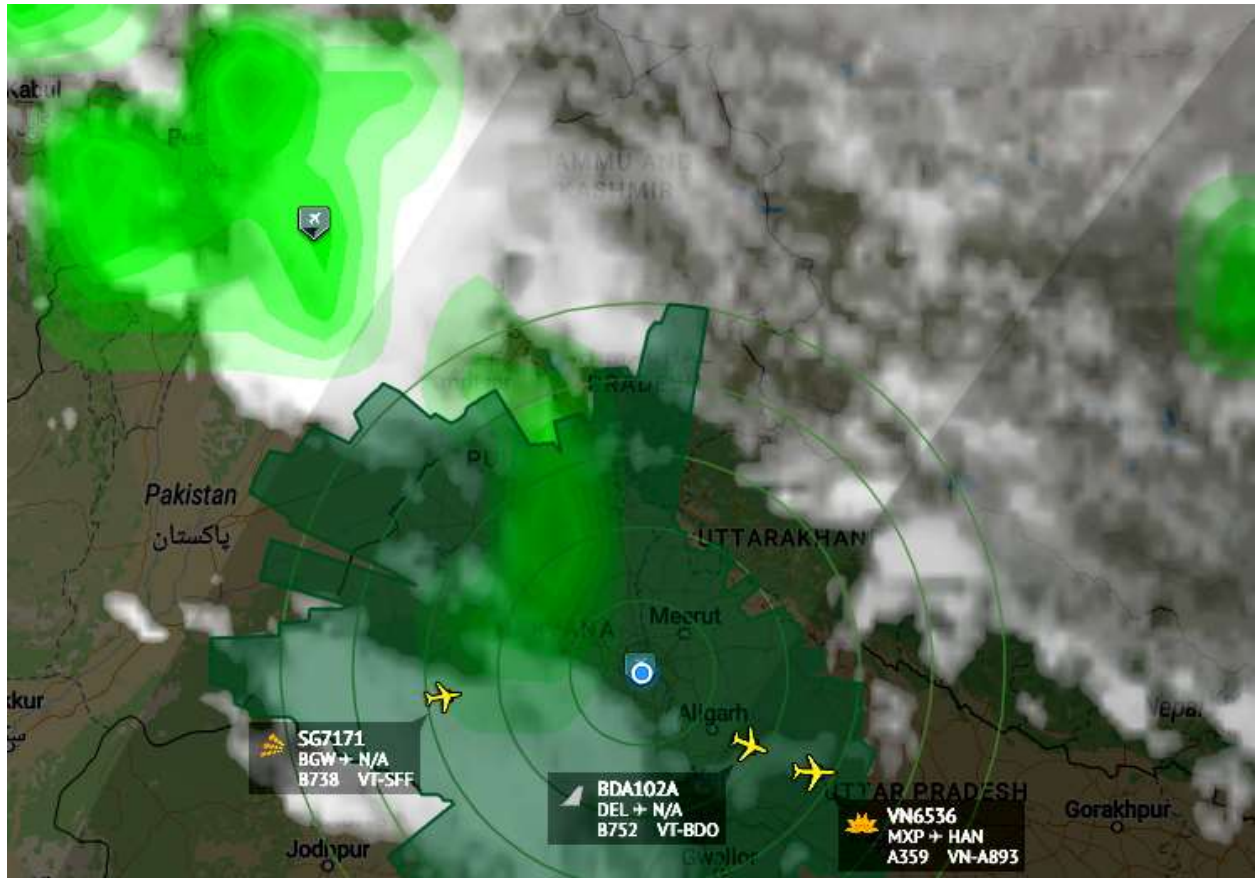

There have been frequent streams of western disturbances crossing northern India. As a result, cold winds are reaching many parts of Indian regions and interacting with moist sea winds coming from both the Arabian Sea and the Bay of Bengal. This has resulted in regular events of thundershower over Northeast India, South Peninsular India, East, and Northwest India.

However, dry weather is likely to prevail over the remaining parts of the country, said officials at IMD.
