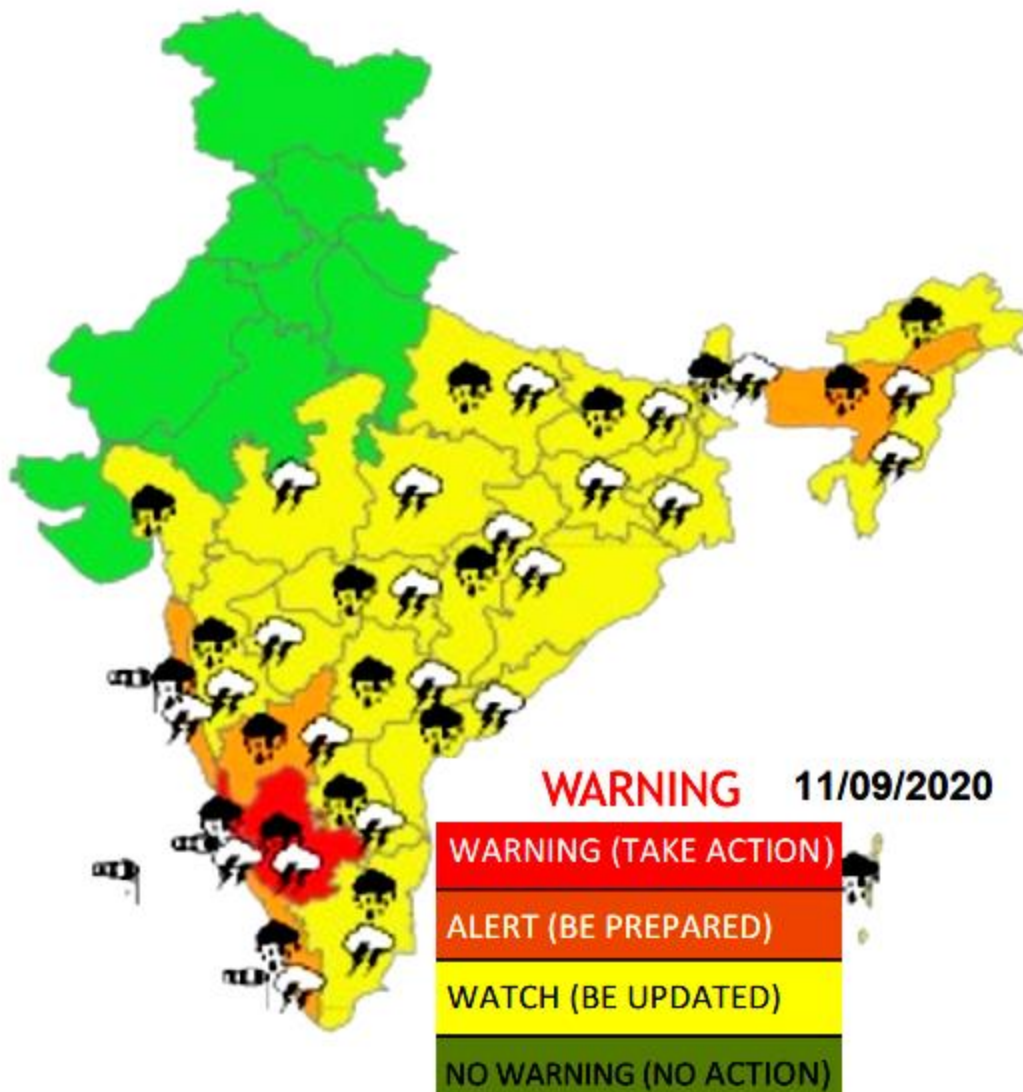


IMD extreme rainfall alert for Coastal and South Interior Karnataka

New Delhi, September 11, 2020 (Vigyan Samachar)

India Meteorological Department (IMD) is issuing an alert for Coastal and South Interior Karnataka predicting extremely heavy rainfall today, 11 September 2020. There is a possibility of very to very heavy rainfall in Coastal Karnataka during 11-13 September 2020 and, South Interior Karnataka on 11 September 2020.

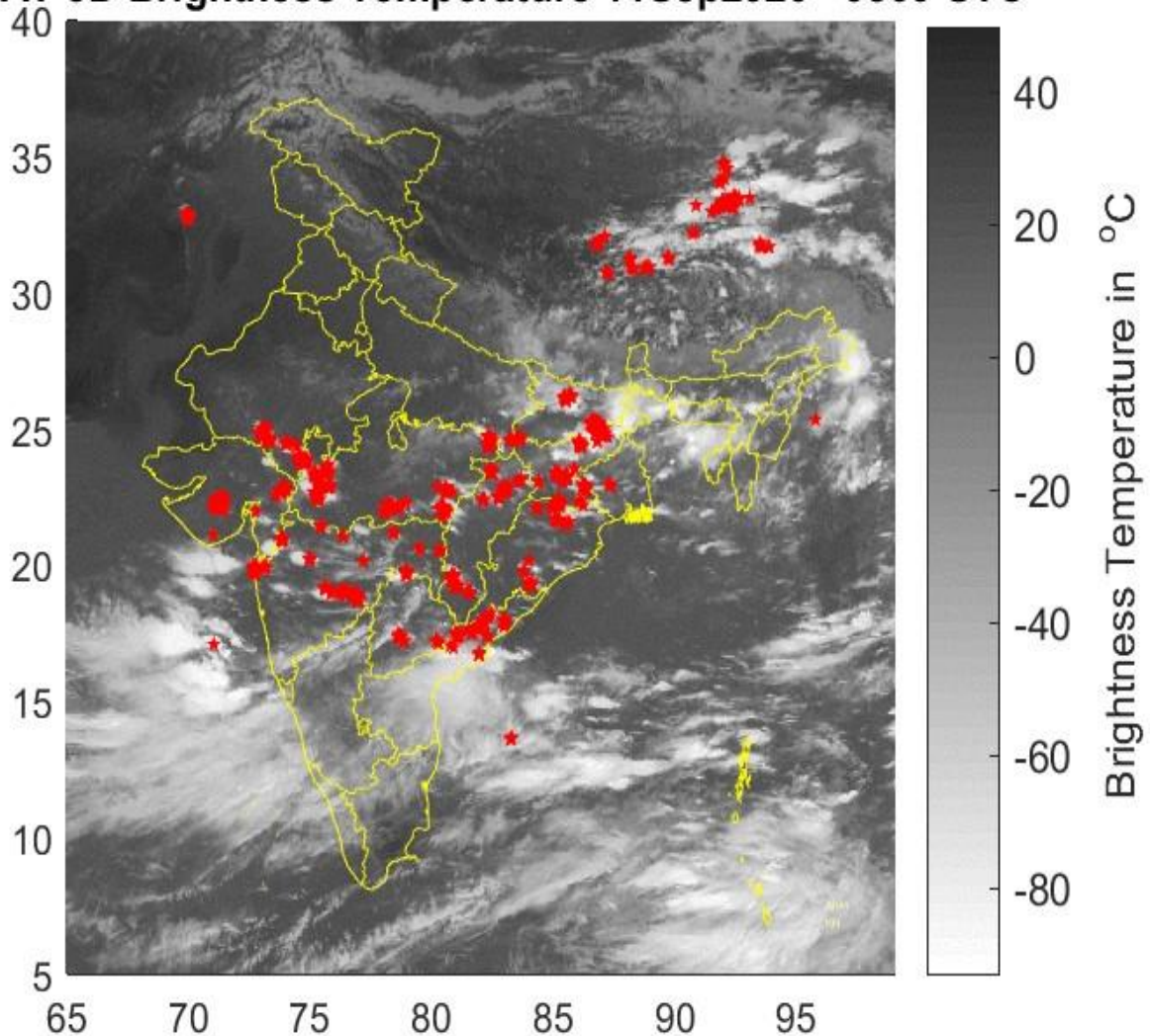


As per IMD, monsoon trough is active and lies to the north of its normal position and its eastern end near to its normal position and likely to shift near southward due to formation of a low pressure area over Westcentral Bay of Bengal off Andhra Pradesh coast around 13th September 2020 is creating conditions that are favorable for heavy

rainfall over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during next 3-4 days, Odisha and over Northeast India during next 3-4 days.

There are also possibility of heavy rainfall over Odisha, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Yanam, Telangana, Maharashtra and Gujarat State from 12 September 2020 onwards, said IMD.

As per the National Weather Forecasting Centre, IMD forecast, there is a heavy probability of thunderstorms with lightning in Chhattisgarh, East Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Sub- Himalayan West Bengal, Sikkim, Manipur, Assam & Meghalaya, Telangana during next 12 hours.
