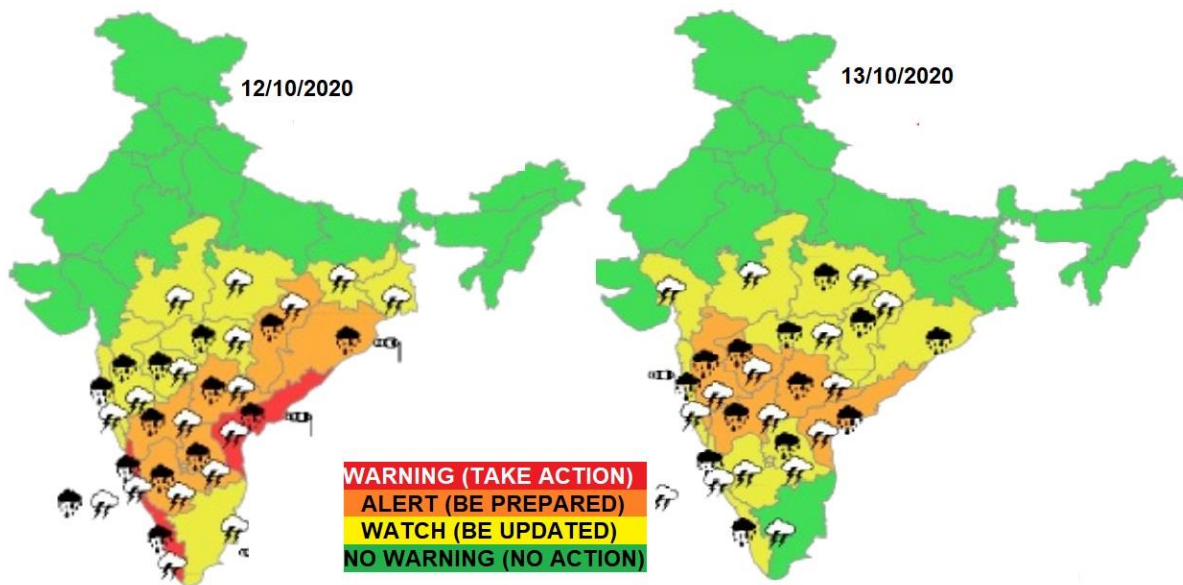
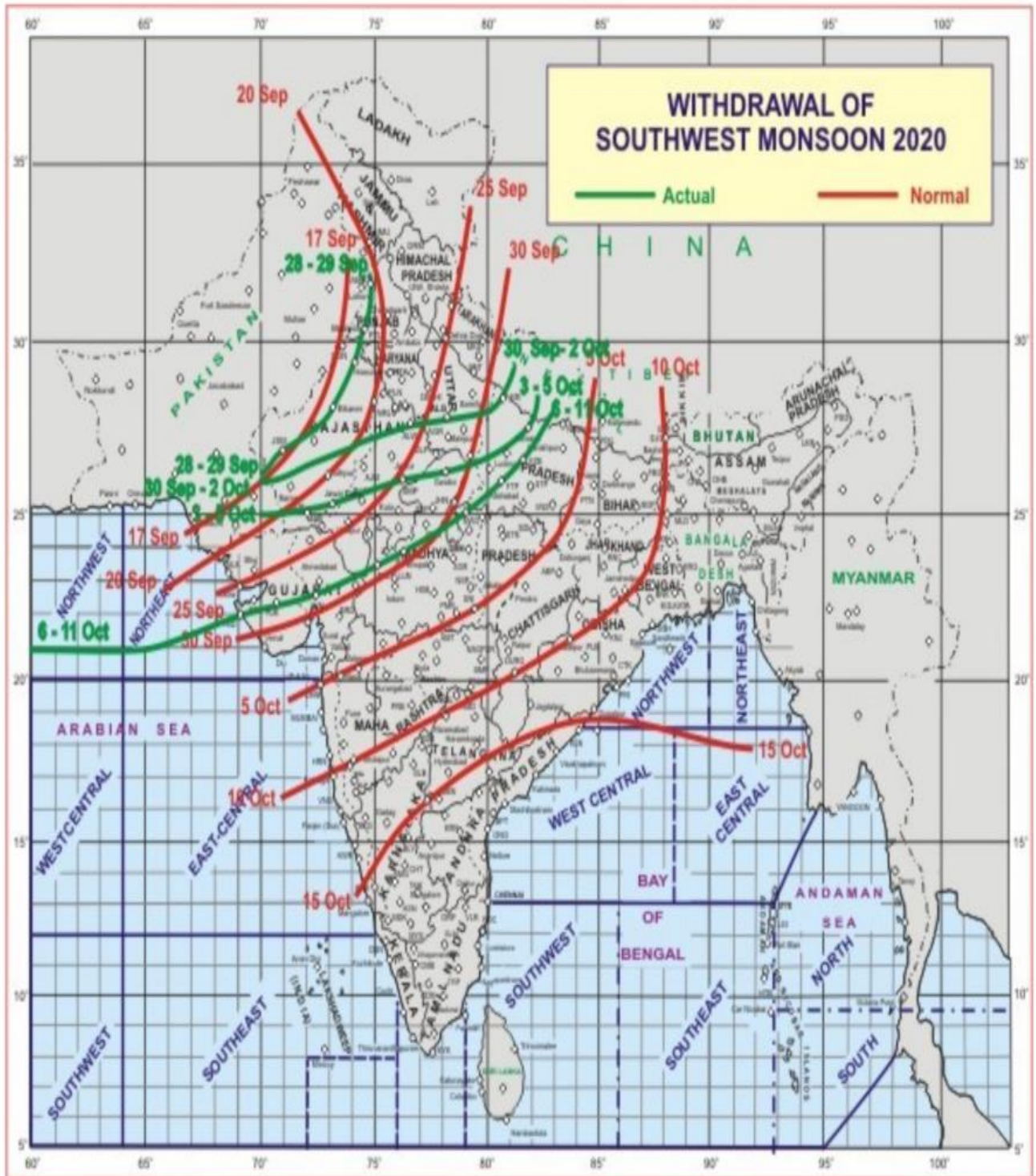


## IMD extreme rainfall alert for Coastal Andhra Pradesh, north Kerala and adjoining Coastal Karnataka

New Delhi, October 12, 2020 (Vigyan Samachar): India Meteorological Department (IMD) is issuing an alert for Coastal Andhra Pradesh, north Kerala and adjoining Coastal Karnataka predicting extremely heavy rainfall ( $\geq 20$  cm per day) today, 12 October 2020. There is a possibility of heavy to very heavy rainfall in south Odisha & adjoining Chhattisgarh, coastal Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Karnataka and north Kerala during next 24 hours and north Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, North Interior Karnataka, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathawada on 13 October 2020.



As per IMD, conditions are becoming favourable for further withdrawal of Southwest-Monsoon from Faizabad, Fatehpur, Nowgong, Rajgarh, Ratlam, Vallabh Vidyanagar, Porbandar during next 2 days. However, dry weather very likely over most parts of the northwest India during 17-19 October 2020.



As per the National Weather Forecasting Centre, IMD forecast, there is a heavy probability of thunderstorms with lightning in Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh,

Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathawada, Konkan & Goa, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Karnataka, Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Kerala & Mahe and Lakshadweep during next 4-5 days.
