

All India Weather Forecast Bulletin from National Weather Forecasting Centre

Forecast for 14th and 15th April, 2020 from National Weather Forecasting Centre, India
Meteorological Department, Ministry of Earth Sciences

14th April, 2020:

- Cyclonic circulation lies over west Afghanistan & neighborhood.
- Scattered to fairly widespread rain/snow with isolated thunderstorm/hailstorm, gusty winds and lightning likely over Western Himalaya region (J&K, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan, Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand)
- Isolated rain/thundershowers likely over Punjab, Haryana, and northwest U.P. Chandigarh & Delhi, Rajasthan
- Maximum Temperatures of 41-43 °C at isolated place over Gujarat region and condition are favourable for further rise in temperature by 2-3 °C and heat wave likely to prevail.
- Heat Wave condition likely to develop over southwest Madhya Pradesh and northwest Vidarbha

15th April, 2020:

- Cyclonic circulation lies over west Afghanistan & neighborhood.
- Scattered to fairly widespread rain/snow with isolated thunderstorm/hailstorm, gusty winds and lightning likely over Western Himalaya region (J&K, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan, Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand)
- Isolated rain/thundershowers likely over Punjab, Haryana, and northwest U.P. Chandigarh & Delhi, Rajasthan

- Maximum Temperatures of 41-43 °C at isolated place over Gujarat region and condition are favourable for further rise in temperature by 2-3 °C and heat wave likely to prevail.
- Heat Wave condition likely to develop over southwest Madhya Pradesh and northwest Vidarbha

16th April, 2020:

- Scattered to fairly widespread rainfall/thunderstorm accompanied with lightning, hail & gusty winds/squally winds very likely over parts of sub-Himalayan West Bengal, Sikkim and north India

17th April, 2020 to 19th April 2020:

- Fairly widespread to widespread rain/thundershowers likely over Northeast India with isolated heavy falls likely over south Assam, Meghalaya and Tripura
- Scattered to fairly widespread rain/thundershowers likely over Western Himalayan region and isolated rain over the plains of Northwest India
- Isolated rain/thundershowers likely over Punjab, Haryana, and northwest U.P. Chandigarh & Delhi, Rajasthan
- Isolated rain/thundershowers likely over parts of East & Peninsular India
- Weather is likely to be dry over rest parts of the country.
