International Workshop on Prediction skill of extreme Precipitation events and tropical cyclones: Present status and future Prospect (IP4)

This event is scheduled from 25-28 November 2019 which is organized by Earth System Science Organization (ESSO) at Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology, Meghdoot Auditorium, Pune, Maharashtra under Ministry of Earth Science, Govt. of India.
