



Due to formation of a low pressure over eastcentral Bay of Bengal and neighbourhood areas during next 12 hours moving towards Coastal Karnataka across Westcentral Bay of Bengal and Peninsular India, during next 12 hours and is likely to persist during subsequent 3-4 days, are creating conditions that are favorable for heavy rainfall over South India, Kerala and Lakshadweep, during next 5 days.

As per IMD, conditions are becoming favourable for further withdrawal of Southwest Monsoon from Faizabad, Fatehpur, Nowgong, Rajgarh, Ratlam, Vallabh Vidyanagar, Porbandar during next 2 days. However, dry weather very likely over most parts of the northwest India during 24-26 October 2020.

As per IMD, scattered rainfall likely over north peninsular India & adjoining Gujarat, west coast, Central and East India and isolated rainfall likely over East Rajasthan, south Uttar Pradesh, Northeast and south peninsular India during 19-21 October 2020. However, dry weather very likely over most parts of the country during the period mentioned.

As per the National Weather Forecasting Centre, IMD forecast, there is a heavy probability of thunderstorms with lightning in Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Gangetic West Bengal, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Konkan & Goa, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Interior Karnataka and Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal during 19-23 October 2020.
