IMD forecasts dense to very dense fog condition over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh and Delhi during next two days

New Delhi, 24 December 2020 (Vigyan Samachar)

India Meteorological Department (IMD) is issuing a forecast for Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, and Delhi predicting dense to very dense fog condition during 24th and 25th December 2020. There is a possibility of dense fog condition in northern parts of Uttar Pradesh during next 2 days and over Assam, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during next 24 hours.



As per the latest weather forecast by IMD, *western disturbance* have created conditions favorable for *scattered to fairly widespread rain/snow* over Jammu, Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit, Baltistan & Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand and isolated rain/thundershowers are expected over adjoining plains of the Northwest India during

the next two subsequent days. However, dry weather would prevail over in the remaining parts of the country.

As per IMD, *ground frost conditions* would exist over Jammu, Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan & Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh and Delhi during the next 24 hours.

IMD also issued **Cold Wave to Severe Cold Wave warning** for Punjab and at isolated pockets over Haryana, Chandigarh, and Delhi on today, 24th December 2020 and **Cold Wave** over Punjab and Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi on 25th December; over Uttar Pradesh during 24 to 25 December and over Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Odisha on 24 December 2020.

As per the National Weather Forecasting Centre, IMD forecast, there is a probability of heavy rainfall over Andaman & Nicobar Islands on 26th December 2020.
