**RISEQ App by NCS: Real Time Information System for Earthquake (RISEQ) by
National Center for Seismology**

The National Center for Seismology (NCS), Ministry of Earth Sciences, Government of India, developed a real-time information system for earthquake app to monitor earthquake activity in the country. The National Center for Seismology maintains a national seismological network of 115 stations each with state-of-the-art equipment and spread across the country for earthquake monitoring round the clock,.

The NCS also monitors earthquake-hit swarms and aftershocks through the deployment of a temporary observatory in the affected area and also performs activities involved in seismic hazard microzonation. This exercise has been initiated for 30 cities in India, including Delhi.

[RISEQ is a mobile app](#) developed by NCS that provides realtime information about the parameters of earthquakes occurring in India. These parameters include location, time, and magnitude.
