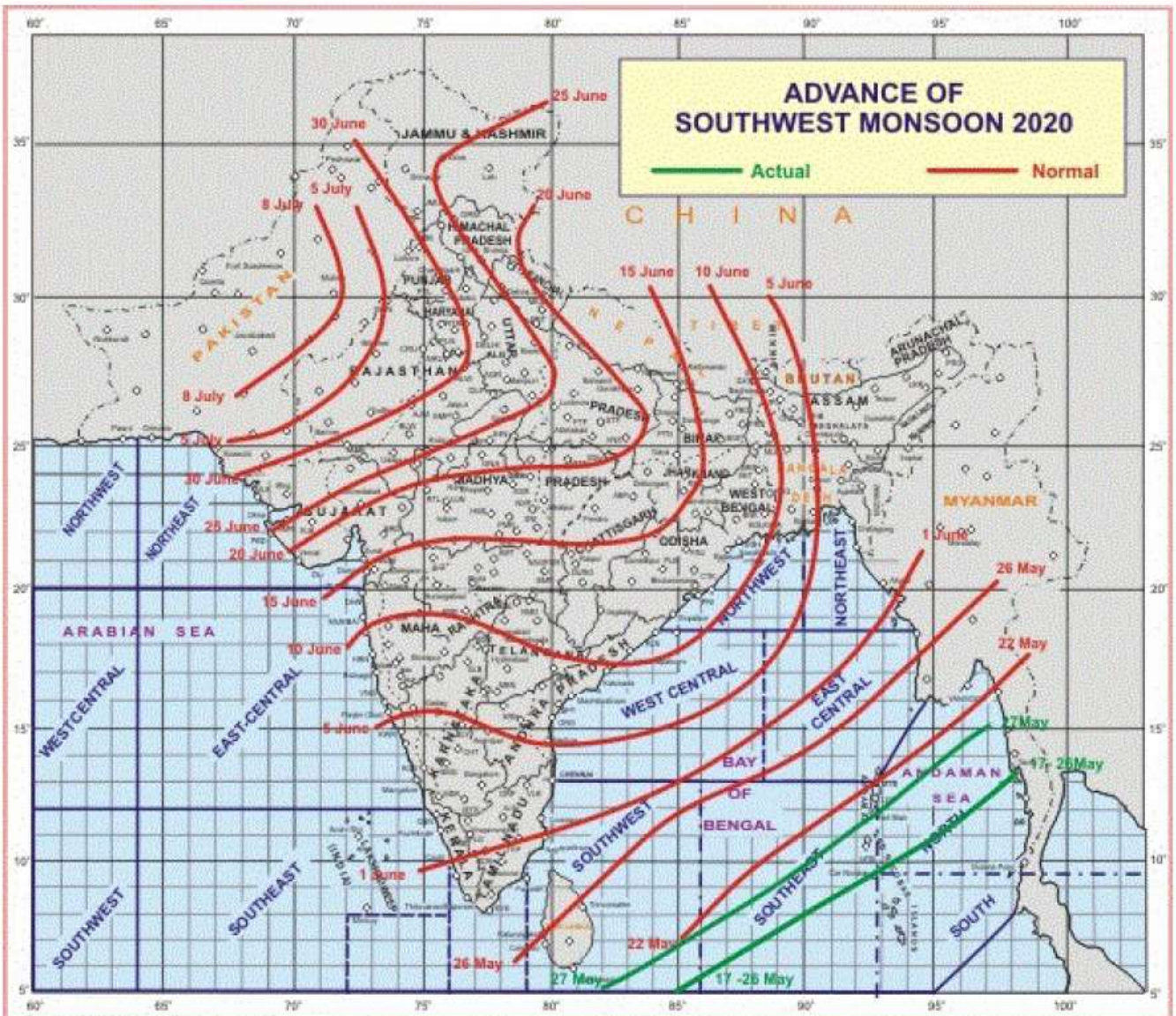


IMD issuing extreme rainfall red alert for Meghalaya, Mizoram, Tripura, and Assam

National Weather Forecasting Centre, India Meteorological Department (IMD) is issuing a red alert for Meghalaya, Mizoram, Tripura, and Assam predicting extreme rainfall during the next two days.

As per IMD, Western disturbance and strong southerly winds from the Bay of Bengal to northeast India at lower tropospheric levels have created conditions that are favorable for heavy to very heavy rainfall likely at isolated places in the parts of Assam and during the next four days.



The green lines are indicative of representation of the old forecast which are modified due to the advance onset of the monsoon indicated by the red lines. However, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Haryana, Delhi, Vidarbha, Madhya Maharashtra, and Marathwada are likely to experience conditions of a heat wave from 27 to 28 May 2020.
