

COVID-19 India update: State-wise total number of confirmed cases, recovered, deaths as on 1st May 2020, 12:10 pm

To reduce the spread of coronavirus in the country, the Central Government has imposed a 40-day lockdown in the country. The Country now gears up for a staggered withdrawal of the lockdown from May 4. As of 1st May 2020, outbreaks of COVID-19 have affected 35,043 people across the country including 24,821 active cases. So far 8889 patients have either been cured or discharged while 1147 deaths have been recorded in the Country. Maharashtra remains the worst affected state with 10,498 cases and 459 deaths. Coronavirus cases reached 3,515 in Delhi as per data provided by the Union Ministry for Health and Family Welfare.

According to the Union Health Ministry, Dr. Harsh Vardhan, of the total active COVID-19 cases in the country, 0.33% of patients are on ventilators and 1.5% are on oxygen support. He said that the mortality rate in COVID-19 patients in India is 3% compared to 7% globally, and about 86% of the fatalities in people are in patients with co-morbidities such as diabetes, high blood pressure, and chronic kidney and heart issues.
