

Third Indian National Groundwater Conference-2020
(18th – 20th February, 2020)

3rd Indian National groundwater conference (INGWC-2020) on Groundwater resources management for sustainable development with the special emphasis on coastal and urban environment at Centre for Water Resources Development and Management (CWRDM), Kozhikode, Kerala, India during 18th to 20th February 2020 (Pre-Conference workshop on Groundwater Modelling will be held on 17th February).

The CWRDM will host the conference in collaboration with Central Ground Water Board (CGWB), National Institute of Technology (NITC) Calicut, Association of Global Groundwater Scientists (AGGS) Coimbatore and GEOFORUM (MS) Aurangabad, India.

This conference will discuss the risks and threats to the coastal groundwater system due to overproduction and various climate change scenarios as well as principles of good groundwater management and governance. It will also provide a selection of examples of proven strategies to protect fresh groundwater resources through abstraction management, demand reduction, freshwater recharge and engineering measures to prevent seawater intrusion.

The aim of this conference is to bring scientists, researchers, students, engineers, water resources experts, government administrators, NGOs and all those who are interested in groundwater and related environmental problems on a common platform and share ideas, knowledge, experiences and to provide an opportunity to exchange techniques and knowledge.

The outcome of the conference will help to better understand the groundwater system that requires a well-designed monitoring.
