

Effect of lockdown on COVID-19 in India as on 28 April 2020

The graph showing the daily confirmed cases in India establishes the fact that the situation is "currently stable" and that the growth of infections is more or less linear and not exponential. It also indicates that the strategies adopted for transitioning to a particular level have been successful. The reduction in growth rate was found after the lockdown and has proven to be effective. This has helped India reach a better position than the rest of the world.

Total number of COVID-19 cases, as per the Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, stands at 31,324 as on 28 April 2020. Meanwhile, the Health Ministry has also said that currently plasma therapy is at an experimental stage and there is no evidence yet to support that it can be used as a treatment for COVID-19.
