Deep Ice Core Drilling Project Workshop at National Centre for Polar and Ocean Research (NCPOR)

India-UK-Norway Workshop on Deep Ice Core Drilling Project in Antarctica started at National Centre for Polar and Ocean Research (NCPOR), Ministry of Earth Sciences, Government of India on 28/11/2019. The main objective of the workshop was to understand the current project hypothesis for shallow to medium depth ice drilling from coastal and inland Antarctica. Scientists from British Antarctic, United Kingdom, Norwegian Polar Institute, Norway & National Centre for Polar and Ocean Research, India discussed the scientific and logistical work plans of the project and focused on the coastal ice sheets and ice rises of Dronning Maud Land and Ingrid Christensen Coast area which would provide areas of higher snow accumulation, that would offer high-resolution climate records.
