

Talk on 'Variability of Salinity in Bay of Bengal' at NCMRWF

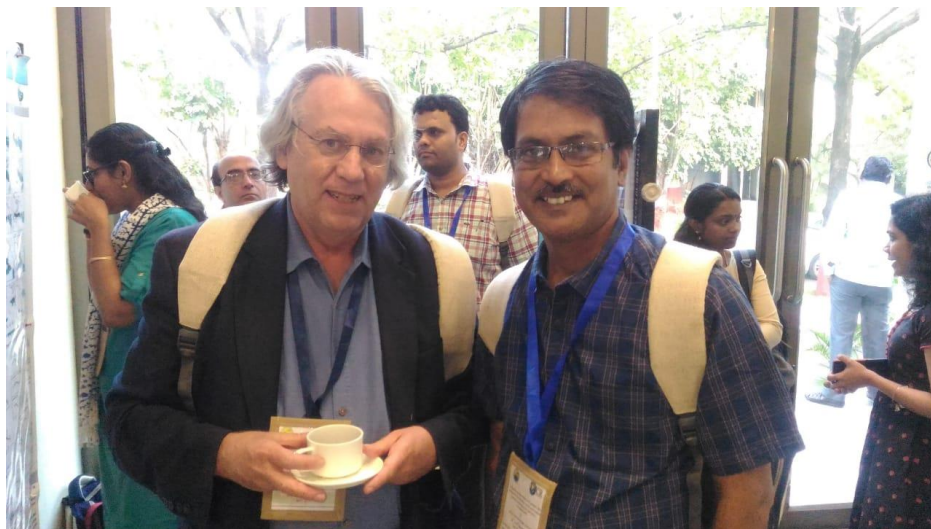
