

DBT-inStem Participates in IISF 2020

New Delhi, Jan 06: DBT- Institute for Stem Cell Science & Regenerative Medicine (DBT-inStem) participated in the 6th India International Science Festival 2020 (IISF 2020) organized by the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research-National Institute of Science, Technology and Development Studies (CSIR-NISTADS), from December 22-25, 2020 through virtual mode.

DBT-inStem's booth included a video, which provided an overview of inStem's activities. Posters on the various thematic programs at inStem covering areas on the control of cell fate, developing therapeutics for wound healing, understanding cardiomyopathies by multi-modal approaches, control of major haemoglobin disorders in India, and gene therapy for major haemoglobin disorders were presented. The posters also included description of activities at the Mouse Genome Engineering Facility (MGEF) & Animal Care and Resource Centre (ACRC), Cryo-EM facility, and the response to COVID-19.



A group of six senior PhD students and postdoctoral fellows were selected for oral presentations in the Young Scientists' Conference (YSC 2020) at IISF-2020. Dr. Anusree Mahanta, a postdoctoral fellow from inStem whose research is supported by the DBT-Wellcome Trust Early Career Fellow won best award for her talk at the conference.
