New Delhi, May 18: The Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India and German Research Foundation (Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft - DFG) have announced new funding opportunities under Indo-German joint collaboration in fundamental research in life sciences. This partnership will enable Indian and German researchers to seek synchronised funding for integrated Indo-German ambitious cutting-edge fundamental research projects including projects on epidemics or pandemics such as the current SARS-CoV-2 pandemic proposing innovative approaches in the academic disciplines covered by the Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India. This joint call will support proposals for a duration of up to three years.
