RULES AND REGULATIONS OF 'COSMOS FROM MY TERRACE'

- 1. VIPNET clubs operating in Delhi and NCR region only can apply for this programme.
- 2. VIPNET club will have to depute two persons (teachers in case of school) for the programme.
- 3. Deputed persons will undergo a one day training programme at Vigyan Prasar, Noida preferably in first week of June 2019.
- 4. No travel support will be provided by Vigyan Prasar to attend the training programme, participants will have to make their own travel arrangements to carry the telescopes back to their places. However tea, lunch and dinner during the programme will be provided by Vigyan Prasar.
- 5. Training programme will have a night sky observation session, so deputed person should be ready to work till late night (i.e. around 9 p.m.).
- 6. After successful completion of the training programme, equipments in the form of telescope, eyepiece etc. will be provided for a period of one year on loan basis.

- 7. The equipments will remain the property of Vigyan Prasar and after completion of one year it will be the responsibility of the VIPNET club to return the telescope back to Vigyan Prasar, NOIDA office.
- 8. Any damage cost/break cost/loss of equipment cost will be recovered from the VIPNET Club.
- 9. VIPNET clubs must need to conduct at least six night sky watch programme for the public, children's etc. in their vicinity and will have to submit the programme report with photographs to Vigyan Prasar on regular basis.
- 10. Vigyan Prasar reserves the right to take back the facility during the course of one year if required.
